Objectives and Issues and outline details for FPL 2012 Vendor Conference.

1 **Objectives**

- 1.1 That Vendors can clarify the variations and expectations of ANSPs and Airspace Users.
- 1.2 That end to end Flight Plan information can be better harmonised and thus reduce the rejection or intervention of Fight Plan messages.
- 1.3 That test plans and test expectations can be agreed and aligned between all FPL users and vendors.
- 1.4 That we can move towards a common interpretation and global understanding of the use of Flight Plan data.

 - (3) Clarification of interpretation of field requirements.
 - (4) Contract dates.
- 2.2 Vendors(Airspace Users)
 - (1) Common set of requirements from Airspace users.
 - (2) Test Plans.
 - (3) Alignment of test scripts.
- 2.3 Airspace Users/3rd Party Suppliers
 - (1) Regional FPL variations via SUPPs.
 - (2) State variations via AIP.

2.4 ANSPs

(1) Testing expectations.

(2) Rationalisation of Flight Plan definitions between Airspace Users and ANSPs (DOF, PBN etc).

3 Conference details

3.1 Attendees

- (1) ANSP Vendors.
- (2) Airspace User system Vendors.
- (3) Regional representatives of ANSPs (preferably Task Force Chairs).
- (4) IATA representation from Key Airspace users or 3rd party representatives.
- (5) Key individuals with expert knowledge of Flight plan usage.

3.2 Venue

- (1) Likely to be Prestwick ACC in Scotland (U.K.).
