#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

#### **VIET NAM**

Lying on the eastern part of the Indochinese peninsula, Viet Nam is a 1,650km long strip of land shaped like the letter "S", stretching between latitudes 8 to 23 degrees North and longitude from 102 to 109 East.

Viet Nam borders China to the north, Laos and Cambodia to the west, and the Pacific Ocean to the east and south.

The current population of Viet Nam is approximately 86 million.

## HA NOI

Ha Noi, the capital city of Viet Nam, has been the cultural, political and commercial center of Viet Nam for nearly a millennium, since the first King of the Ly Dynasty chose it as the capital of his kingdom in 1010.

Ha Noi still has many historical and cultural heritage sites, including over 600 pagodas and recently discovered palaces of the ancient dynasties. It has been known as one of the most charming cities of Viet Nam with beautiful lakes, shaded boulevards and the Ancient Quarter with over 100-year old architecture.

The city has become one of the most attractive cities in Asia to travelers. While its slow-paced and peaceful lifestyle are still being preserved, a new face of modern life has been developing in every corner of the city day by day, marked by the rising of modern skyscrapers

#### **CLIMATE**

Viet Nam is located in both a tropical and a temperate zone. It is characterized by strong monsoon influences, but has a considerable amount of sun, a high rate of rainfall, and high humidity. Regions located near the tropics and in the mountainous regions are endowed with a temperate climate.

March is the last leg of spring in the North. Temperatures go around 24°C (75°F) and humidity proves oppressive. Some short downpours should be expected, mostly at night. Hanoi has many cloudy mornings.

#### **LANGUAGES**

Vietnamese is the national language. However, some English is widely spoken at places where tourists frequent.

#### **CURRENCY**

The Vietnamese currency is Dong (VND). Vietnamese notes are available in denominations of 500, 1000, 2000, 5000, 10000, 20000, 100000, 200000, and 500000, with several types of coins of little value. The currency trades at about **21 VND** to the US dollars. US dollars are widely accepted at hotels, but the local currency is used in taxis and shops. ATM machines that dispense VND are widely available but usually have a limit of VND 2,000,000/transaction and VND 20,000,000/day.

Foreign currency may be exchanged at your hotel, banks and authorized money changing shops. Exchanging money anywhere else is illegal and the laws are strictly enforced.

Credit card acceptance, including American Express, Visas and MasterCard, is spreading in higher-end hotels, restaurants and shops in big cities.

#### **ELECTRICITY**

Vietnam uses 220V electricity nationwide. In the South, outlets are often US-style flat pins. In the North, many outlets fit round pins. As the electrical current varies, you should use a surge protector when running sensitive electronic equipment like laptops

#### WATER

It is recommended that visitors drink bottled water. Bottled purified water, spring water or mineral water is often supplied by hotels, and sold in all grocery stores.

## **BUSINESS HOURS**

Government offices and museums open early, around 8:00 am, and close between 4:00 pm and 5:00 pm. Banks open the same times. When banking in the Viet Nam, it is advisable to have your passport with you for identification.

Avoid doing business from 11:30 am to 2 pm, when many people are either at lunch or resting.

## TIME ZONE

Time in Viet Nam is 7 hours ahead of Coordinated Universal Time (UTC+7).

### **AIRPORT TAX**

Airport tax is included in air tickets.

#### **IMMIGRATION AND CUSTOMS**

## 1. Following items are given duty free allowance:

- a) Not more than 1.5 litters of liquor above 22% Al Vol.
- b) 400 cigarettes, 100 cigars, 500gram of raw tobacco.
- c) Not more than 2 litter of liquor below 22% Al Vol.
- d) Perfume or jewelry for personal use.
- e) Accompanying baggage with value less than 5,000,000 VND

#### 2. It should be noted that the following items are required to declare:

- a) Cameras, camcorders, and other electronic equipment not for personal use.
- b) Jewelry not for personal use.
- c) Currency over US\$ 7000 or over 15,000,000 VND.
- d) Gold over 300 grams

## **Noi Bai International Airport**

Hanoi's Noi Bai International Airport is about 35 km, or approximately 40 minutes by car, to the center of Ha Noi. Four-seat taxi from Noi Bai to Sofitel Plaza Hotel or any other places in the center of Ha Noi costs around US\$ 15. Tickets for mini-bus from the Airport to the center of the city costs from US\$ 2 to US\$ 3.
