SUMMARY

This paper presents recent activities in Indonesia with respect to the transition from Aeronautical Information Services (AIS) to Aeronautical Information Management (AIM).

1. **INTRODUCTION**

- 1.1. Some efforts regarding to support ICAO programs to the transition from AIS to AIM as we already informed to the AAITF/6 in Bangkok, Thailand 15 17 March 2011 which is still on going process including development system at Soekatno-Hatta International Airport.
- 1.2. Pre-flight Information Service should be made available at International Airport, but yet the way of providing this services is still on manual concept rather than automated or even via internet connection. Soekarno-Hatta International Airport has to provide for about 1,500 copied of paper of Pre-flight Information Bulletin (PIB) per day to satisfy the need of user. For efficiency, accuracy and cost effectiveness, the new infrastructure should be installed at Aerodrome AIS Unit to enable users to access PIB from internet connection.
- 1.3. The Integrated Aeronautical Information System (IAIS) and Electronic Charting had been installed at Aerodrome AIS Unit Soekarno-Hatta International Airport on 1st February 2012, IAIS is already comply with ICAO New Flight Plan and Electronic Charting is integrated with IAIS, both are ready to be connected to internet.

2. IMPLEMENTATION PLAN

2.1. Internet Pre-flight Information Services at Soekarno-Hatta International Airport will be launched on August 2012. Pre-flight Information Bulletin will be associated with graphic NOTAM as IAIS is integrated with Electronic Charting.
