APEX for Safety

- APEX for Safety (Airport Excellence for Safety)
- ACI initiative launched in May 2011
- Technical assistance/advice to improve safety
- Presented to APRAST/1 in Feb 2012



How Does APEX Work?

- Airport (Host) request for assistance
- ACI assembles team
 - Safety Partner (safety expert from other airports)
 - ICAO staff
 - ACI staff
 - Others experts
- Team conducts on-site review (1 to 2 weeks)
- Report on gaps and recommendations
