SUMMARY

Airservices Australia, AOPA and the Aircraft Electronics Association have produced a Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) related to ADS-B related to General Aviation.

1. Introduction

- 1.1 In Australia the key stakeholders in Air Traffic Management planning meet regularly in an organisation called ASTRA (see www.astra.aero). The Surveillance Technology Working Group (STWG) prepares advice for ASTRA on issues related to ADS-B and other surveillance technologies.
- 1.2 The STWG members recently prepared a Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) document related to ADS-B for the Australian General Aviation community.
