- 4.2 Check-in will start at the meeting venue on **Monday 15 July 2024** and on all days of the meeting **from 07:30** to 08:30.

5. Transportation

- 5.1 Transportation will be provided between the meeting venue (Radisson Blu Hotel) and the hotels recommended by the Organizing Committee.
- 5.2 Transportation will be provided from Libreville international airport to the respective hotels. A desk will be available in the airport arrivals hall to welcome delegates and provide them with the necessary assistance. Similarly, transport will be organized between the hotels and Libreville airport.
- 5.3 Transport to and from the selected hotels (main entrance) to the meeting venue (Radisson Blu Hotel) will be provided between 07:30 and 08:30, and at 17:00 from the meeting venue to the various hotels.

5.4 Taxis are available and can be taken from your hotel. The GOZEM cab company provides transport on request, with safe, air-conditioned and comfortable metered cabs. Rides can be requested by downloading the GOZEM application from Google Play or App Store (<u>https://gozem.co/ga/fr/</u>).

6. Hotels information

6.1 Participants are requested to make their own hotel reservations and to indicate that they will be attending an ANAC meeting in order to benefit from special accommodation rates/negotiated rates. A list of recommended hotels is attached to this newsletter. Participants are advised to confirm their hotel reservations as soon as possible (send reservations and itinerary to the Accommodation Commission) to avoid last-minute inconveniences.

7. Weather and clothing

- 7.1. Gabon is crossed by the equator. The climate is therefore equatorial, hot and humid. There is a long rainy season (February-June), a short rainy season (September-December), a long dry season (June-September) and a short dry season (December-January). However, with climate change, it is very common for rains to occur during the dry season.
- 7.2. Average temperatures range from 23°C to 29°C. Extremes range from 18°C to 36°C. Humidity averages 85% and can reach 100% in the rainy season. Weather conditions in July are as follows:

8. Passports and Visa

- 8.1. Participants are invited to make their own visa applications. They should use the invitation letter to the event and their official letter of designation.
- 8.2. Visa applicants have two options: either visit the nearest consulate or apply online before arriving in Gabon at https://evisa.dgdi.ga.

<u>Note:</u> We recommend that you obtain an entry visa before your trip.

- 8.3. Furthermore, according to circular 0001 MISDL/MDN of 19 October 2017, relating to the free movement of persons in the CEMAC zone, nationals of the following member states **Cameroon, Central African Republic, Republic of Congo, Chad and Equatorial Guinea**, holding a passport valid for at least three (3) months are not subject to an entry visa for Gabon for any stay not exceeding three (3) months (90 days).
- 8.4. Similarly, according to circular 0002 MISDL/MDN/MAECFIR of 20 October 2017, nationals of G20 member States and those of member States of the Gulf Cooperation Council will apply for the issuance of an entry visa to Gabon upon arrival, at approved international crossing points, with the services in charge of immigration. They can, however, apply for a visa via <u>https://evisa.dgdi.ga</u>. Travelers must have a passport valid for at least three (3) months.

9. Health

- 9.1 Participants are reminded that a valid yellow fever vaccination certificate is required.
- 9.2 Participants should ensure that they have valid health insurance to cover all medical expenses during their stay in Gabon.

10. Information on COVID-19

Before departure for Libreville

- Covid-19 testing is no longer mandatory prior to boarding flights to Libreville. However, regular Covid-19 screening is encouraged.
- The Passenger Tracking Form is no longer mandatory prior to departure.

Departure from Libreville

- Covid testing is no longer mandatory for departing from Gabon by air. However, Covid testing (at own expense) is available at health centers and other designated sites for all travelers whose destination may require COVID-19 testing.

11. Banking and currency

The country's legal tender, the CFA franc (XAF), is based on the decimal system. Banknotes are in denominations of 500, 1,000, 2,000, 5,000 and 10,000, while the most widely used coins are in denominations of 100.

- 11.1 The CFA Franc parity is fixed for the euro and is set at Eur = 655.957 FCFA.
- 11.2 The exchange rate against the dollar (USD) is determined by interbank trade, which varies on a daily basis. Participants can obtain up-to-date information from the Internet.
- 11.3 Commercial banks and currency exchange bureaus provide currency exchange services. Most banks are open from 08:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Monday to Friday and from 08:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. on Saturdays. Hotels can provide currency exchange services for a small fee.
- 11.4 There are exchange offices at the airport that convert international currencies (Euro, Dollar). Opening hours are Monday to Friday, 8.00 am to 4.00 pm.
- 11.5 ATMs are available in the airport lobby.

12 Telephony

- 12.1 From abroad, dial the area code +241, followed by the number you wish to call, omitting the leading 0. Telephone and communication services are available throughout the country, and Internet access is also available.
- 12.2 Two cell phone companies: Moov Africa Gabon Telecom and Airtel Gabon offer a wide range of services.
- 12.3 SIM card sales outlets are available at the airport.

13 Power supply

13.1 Power sockets are type C or E. Local mains voltage is 220 V at a frequency of 50 Hz. We advise you to bring your own adapter.

14 Security

- 14.1 Although Gabon has a good level of security, in the event of an emergency police can be reached at 112 (free number) or +24165818181 (Préfecture de Police).
- 14.2 Gabon's air, land and sea borders are open and the situation is stable. However, please be vigilant when traveling. A curfew is in force between 2am and 5am. Please respect this curfew and avoid demonstration areas and large gatherings.
