Monday/Tuesday 15 - 16 July 2024: Tenth Meeting of the Directors General of Civil Aviation of the Africa-Indian Ocean region (AFI-DGCA/10)

Objectives:

To review latest developments in aviation, the evolution of the aviation performance in all ICAO strategic objectives in the AFI region, key priorities and issues related to capacity building in the region.

Participants:

- Directors General of Civil Aviation of the AFI region, to be accompanied by technical experts as necessary, to take full advantage of the meeting's deliberations; and
- Invited representatives of international and regional organizations, aviation stakeholders and industry.

Wednesday 17 July 2024:

Twenty-Seventh Meeting of the Steering Committee of the Comprehensive Regional Implementation Plan for Aviation Safety in Africa (AFI Plan) and Thirteen Meeting of the Steering Committee of the Comprehensive Regional Implementation Plan for Aviation Security and Facilitation in Africa (AFI SECFAL Plan)
