Advance Passenger Information (API)

API involves the capture of a passenger's or crew member's biographic data and flight details by the aircraft operator prior to departure.

This information is electronically transmitted to the border control agencies in the destination or departure country.



Passenger Name Record (PNR)

PNR data comprises passenger information recorded by airline reservation systems for each journey booked.



Passenger Data Single Window

The concept of a **Passenger Data Single Window** aims to create efficiencies in data transmission and avoid duplication of costs and resources for both aircraft operators and States.

Status of implementation of API and PNR

❖ Six (6) AFI States with API in Force:

❖ Three (3) AFI States with PNR in Force :

- ✓ *Egypt*
- ✓ *Mali*
- ✓ *Seychelles*

- Nineteen (19) African States are either developing their legal basis for API or are expecting to do so soon: *Algeria, Angola, Botswana, Côte d'Ivoire, Ethiopia, Gambia, Ghana, Kenya, Morocco, Mozambique, Nigeria, Senegal, Sierra Leone, Sudan, Tanzania, Togo, Tunisia, Uganda, Zambia*

- Ten (10) African States are either developing their legal bases for PNR or are expecting to do so soon: *Algeria, Botswana, Ghana, Kenya, Mauritius, Nigeria, Rwanda, Senegal, South Africa, Togo*
