# ACT- SAF Partner States

Several SAF related initiatives in Africa by some States

To date, **58%** of ESAF and WACAF States have joined the ACT-SAF Programme

Encouraging States to consider becoming ACT SAF Partners

## States:

ACT-SAF Partner States from both ESAF and WACAF Regions

**ESAF:** Botswana, Ethiopia, Kenya, Madagascar, Malawi, Mauritius, Mozambique, Rwanda, Seychelles, South Africa, South Sudan, Tanzania, Zimbabwe, Zambia, Namibia

**WACAF:** Burkina Faso, Cabo Verde, Cameroon, Cote d'Ivoire, Congo Brazzaville, Equatorial Guinea, Gabon, Ghana, Nigeria, Senegal, Togo, Mauritania, Mali

Cote d'Ivoire offered financial resources to ACT-SAF

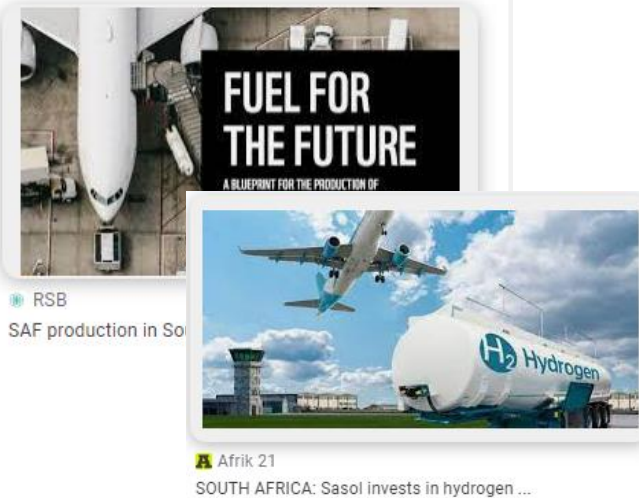

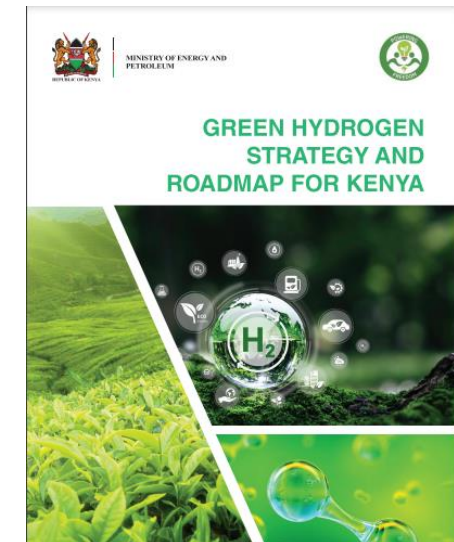

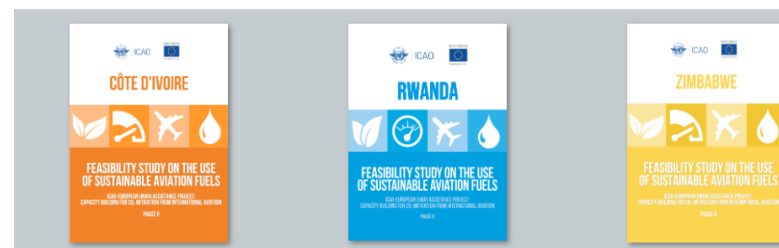

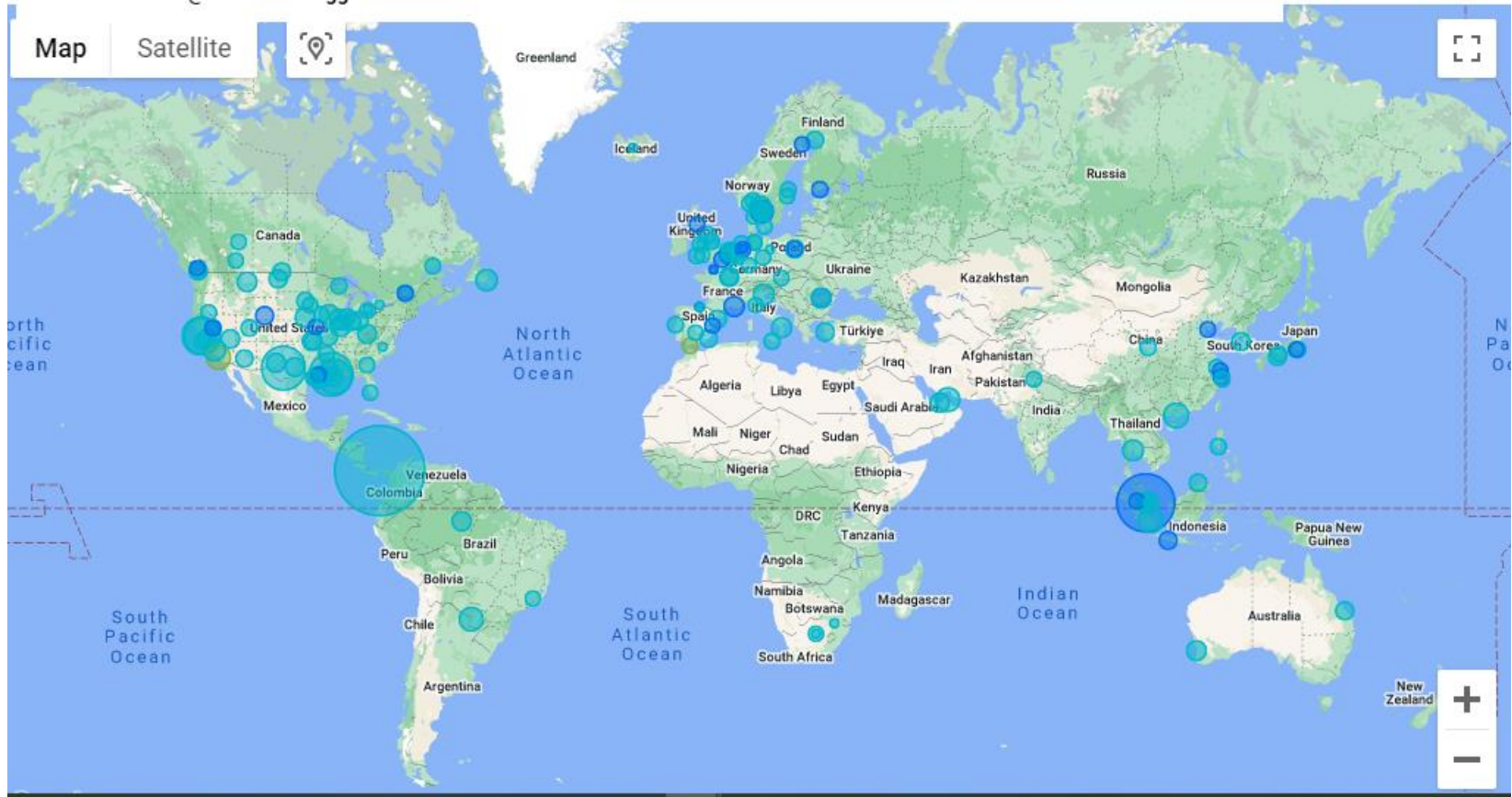

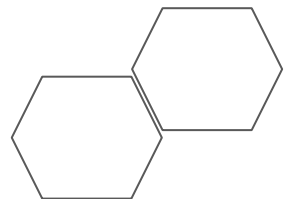
# SAF Production facilities: Africa compared to the rest of the world
