2. Registration

2.1 Registration of participants will take place on **4 June 2024 from 08:00 am to 08:30 am** at the **Hilton Garden Inn Windhoek**.

3. Opening Session

3.1 The official opening of the Seminar will take place on **4 June 2024 at 09:00 am.**

4. Working Language

4.1 The Seminar will be conducted in English language only. The Seminar will be paperless, and participants are required to bring their portable computers/laptops for access.

5. Transport

5.1 *From the Airport*

Taxis are available from **Hosea Kutako International Airport** to the city centre and the fare normally is between **N\$ 400.00**. However, it is advisable to agree on the fare before getting into the vehicle. Enquiries may be made at the airport information desks/counters upon arrival.

5.2 *Transport arrangements to the Seminar venue*

Transport will be provided to the meeting venue. Delegates must remember to confirm their participation (by last day of registration) for proper transport logistics.

6. Hotel Information

6.1 Participants are advised to make their hotel reservations and indicate that they are attending an ICAO meeting in order to take advantage of the special accommodation rates. A list of recommended hotels is attached at the end of this bulletin.

7. Entry Visa

7.1 All visitors to the Republic of Namibia must have a valid passport (at least six months after the date of departure). Participants who require visas to enter Namibia should fill in a visa application form and send to the meeting coordinators to assist with acquiring the necessary visas before departure.

7.3 Foreign nationals are exempted from visa requirements when travelling to Namibia from:

Angola, Armenia, Australia, Austria, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Belgium, Botswana, Brazil, Canada, Cuba, Denmark, Eswatini, Finland, France, Germany, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Japan, Kazakhstan, Kenya, Kyrgyzstan, Lechtenstein, Lesotho, Luxemburg, Malawi, Malaysia, Mauritius, Moldova, Mozambique, Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Portugal, Russian Federation, Seychelles, Singapore, South Africa, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Tajikistan, Tanzania, Turkmenistan, Ukraine, United Kingdom, United States of America, Uzbekistan, Zambia, Zimbabwe.

7.4 Countries to benefit from visas upon arrival at Hosea Kutako International Airport:

Benin, Burkina Faso, Burundi, Cabo Verde, Cameroon, Central African Republic (CAR), Chad, Comoros, Cote d'Ivoire, Djibouti, Equatorial Guinea, Eritrea, Gabon, Gambia, Guinea, Guinea-Bissau, Liberia, Madagascar, Mauritania, Niger, Rwanda, Sao Tome and Principe, Sierra Leone, Togo, Tunisia, Uganda, Western Sahara Republic

The visa upon arrival will be issued upon payment of visa fee of N\$1080.00 or about US\$71.00, depending on the exchange rate and will be valid for up to 90 days.

8. Health

8.1 It is strongly recommended for participants to have travel insurance (including health) for the duration of their stay in Namibia. Participants should particularly ensure that their insurance is applicable in Namibia. Furthermore, they should carry evidence of current health/hospitalization insurance such as cards that may be produced to health institutions should the need arise. Participants are also encouraged to provide information during registration, on their next of kin who may be contacted on behalf of the participant should the need arise.

8.2 Yellow Fever

There is no risk of yellow fever in Namibia, however, a yellow fever vaccination certificate is required for travelers aged 9 months or over arriving from countries with risk of yellow fever transmission. Travelers having transited a country with risk of yellow fever transmission but not leaving the transit areas are exempted.

8.3 Countries with risk of yellow fever transmission requiring proof of vaccination against yellow fever are:

Angola, Benin, Burkina Faso, Burundi, Cameroon, Central African Republic, Chad, Congo, DRC, Ivory Coast, Ethiopia, Gabon, Gambia, Ghana, Guinea, Guinea Bissau, Guinea Equatorial, Kenya, Liberia, Mali, Mauritania, Niger, Nigeria, Sudan, South Sudan, Congo, Senegal, Sierra Leone, Togo and Uganda.

8.4 Persons who fail to produce a valid yellow fever vaccination certificate to the port health officials may be required to take the vaccination at the point of entry against payment of US\$15 (subject to change by the appropriate authority). The officials may take other actions in accordance with applicable regulations and procedures. 9. Weather

9.1 Forecast maximum/minimum temperatures for (June) are a low of 10°C and a high up to 24°C.

9.2 The local time is GMT+2.

10. Local Currency and Foreign Exchange Rates

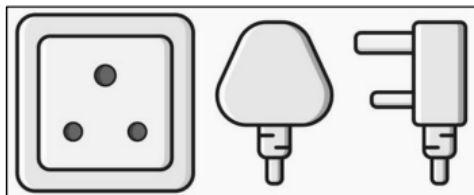
- 10.1 The basic unit of currency is the Namibian Dollar (N\$) and the South African Rand (ZAR). Notes are in denominations of 10, 20, 30, 50, 100 and 200, Coins used are in denominations of 1, 2 and 5 Dollars.
- 10.2 The Namibian Dollar exchange rates are determined by the interbank trade which varies daily. Participants may wish to obtain current information from the internet.
- 10.3 Namibia enjoys commercial and merchant banking services. Most banks convert international currencies. Banking hours are from Monday to Friday; 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.; with a number of banks open on Saturdays from 9:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. ATM services for VISA Electron and MasterCard card holders are available at many points in Windhoek. Forex Bureau are also available in the city. Visitors would however be advised to deal with Bureau with a valid and displayed license. On arrival at (Hosea Kutako International Airport), forex services are available within customs hall, during the airport operational hours.

11. Telephones

- 11.1 Worldwide direct connections are available, using the international code or telephone operator as necessary. From outside Namibia, dial 264 followed by the area code (for landline numbers) and the required number. There are two (2) cellular phone (mobile) operators in Namibia **MTC and Telecom Namibia**.
