

BRIEF ON EUR/NAT STATES RESTRICTIONS DUE TO COVID-19

Albania	No flight suspensions to Albania Please check immigration restriction.
Algeria	<i>Flights to Algeria are suspended. - This does not apply to medevac and repatriation flights.</i>
Andorra	<i>Apply the relevant Coronavirus (COVID-19) regulations of France or Spain, whichever must be transited to enter Andorra.</i>
Armenia	All previously granted permits for two and more charter and scheduled international pax flights are prohibited Entry of foreign citizens prohibited, some exemptions granted
