ICAO NCLB Initiative

- Launched on ICAO's 70th Anniversary on 7 December 2014
- ICAO Assembly, adopted resolution A39-23, endorsing the NCLB initiative
- Supports UN 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development
- Reflects ICAO's mandate and operations
- For ALL States and ALL Strategic Objectives
- Focus on increased State implementation of ICAO policies, plans and SARPs and enhanced ICAO support for States with prioritized needs
- Raise awareness on the importance and benefits of improved global air connectivity and aviation system access for sustainable growth, development and socio-economic prosperity travel, trade, tourism, employment sectors

By the end of 2025

No fatal accidents in commercial scheduled flights

No international aerodrome without a runway safety team

No country below 40% EI in any operational or air navigation related field


No country without an autonomous and effective CAA

No country with significant safety concerns

No country without aerodrome certification capabilities

No instrument runway without a PBN approach







TECHNICAL COOPERATION / TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE

- Technical Cooperation (TC) is any project requested and funded by States and/or Organizations and implemented through TCB on a cost-recovery basis, where all the direct and indirect costs related to the project are recovered.
- Technical Assistance (TA) is any assistance provided by ICAO to States, which is funded by the Regular Budget and/or Voluntary Funds and implemented through any Bureau/Office depending on the nature and duration of the project











- Under ICAOs global initiative "No Country Left Behind" (NCLB), Regional Office EUR NAT developed a Capacity Building Regional Programme to be implemented through Technical Assistance projects (EUR CBP-TA), according to the availability of funds and human resources.
- A project management approach for the ongoing and new activities, has been identified as the optimum way to do more with less. Draft EURNAT-DGCA Statement/ 2017/WP/08_1 – NCLB-EUR/NAT Regional Capacity Building Technical Assistance Programme (EUR/NAT CBP-TA)

That the EURNAT-DGCA:

- a) endorse the development and implementation of the EUR/NAT Capacity Building Technical Assistance Programme (EUR/NAT CBP-TA), under the NCLB framework;
- b) commit to support the EUR/NAT CBP-TA and urge States, international organizations, and industry to contribute with necessary resources for its implementation through the established ICAO mechanisms; and
- c) commit to coordinate with ICAO, and specifically with the EUR/NAT Office, their assistance requests/support and implementation activities.
