#### **Scenario**




A civil passenger aircraft with flight number 000, carrying 5 crew members, and 155 passengers, was flying from Lebanon to Larnaca airport. While in the process of landing at 09:55, the hydraulic system of the landing gear failed, which caused the pilot to perform an emergency landing. Due to this failure, the aircraft slid outside the landing gauge and ended up at the salt lake located outside the airport.






