
Key messages:

- Demand:
- ➤ The future demand for SAF in Austria is enormous approx. 700.000 t in 2050
- > Large quantities of raw materials/feedstock (biomass and energy) are needed, as well as a rapid ramp-up of SAF production.



- > The demand for raw materials is not met due to high competition with other sectors.
- > The current production capacities are limited.
- > Imports will play a crucial role in securing the availability of SAF in Austria.
- Conclusion: Political measures (including financial support) are needed to ramp up the production and use of SAF.
