



## Foundational SAF Training & Policy Implementation Workshops

Contextual region/country specific training covering:

- introduction to SAF;
- SAF sustainability and reporting under CORSIA;
- SAF technology and certification;
- SAF policies;
- SAF conversion processes;
- SAF accounting and book and claim systems;
- SAF logistics;
- and SAF feasibility assessment.

The workshop covers basic skills and strategies for creating and applying compelling and influential policy advice papers, stimulating growth of SAF supply and creating demand for SAF.

## Feasibility Studies and Business Implementation Studies

**Feasibility Studies:** For States where no SAF Feasibility Study has been completed nationally. SAF feasibility studies identify the potential for the development and deployment of SAF in the state on the basis of the ICAO ACT-SAF Feasibility Study Template.

Business Implementation Studies: For States where a SAF Feasibility Study has already been completed and shown conclusive prospects for the establishment of a SAF market, notably with indications of feedstock availability, SAF production costs and market prices. The objective will be to provide a "ready-to-invest" report, to attract investors and drive the start of a concrete SAF project.
