- Setting the standards for aircraft designed and used in Canada to ensure all meet certification requirements and operational airworthiness
- Overseeing the licensing and training of pilots, crew members and aircraft maintenance engineers

Mission

To develop and administer policies and regulations for the safest civil aviation system for Canada and Canadians using a systems approach to managing risks.

Vision

An integrated and progressive civil aviation system that promotes a proactive safety culture.

Key Points for Canada

- Progress on AAM use-cases will vary by regional needs and context
- TC is working to study human factors and other safety considerations for autonomy and AAM
- Social acceptance is key
- Maintaining trust in the safety of the aviation system while enabling innovation is paramount
