### TCCA Activities

- Working with industry and government partners to help keep planes, people and airports safe and secure
- Administering the *Canadian Aviation Regulations* (CARs)
- Setting the standards for aircraft designed and used in Canada to ensure all meet certification requirements and operational airworthiness
- Overseeing the licensing and training of pilots, crew members and aircraft maintenance engineers

To develop and administer policies and regulations for the safest civil aviation system for Canada and Canadians using a systems approach to managing risks.

### Vision

An integrated and progressive civil aviation system that promotes a proactive safety culture.
