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Article 12 Task Force: Milestones

HLSC 2015)	 Recommended that "ICAO should establish a coordination mechanism to assist States in resolving safety issues related to foreign aircraft operators"
	 Outlined that A12 "does not provide guidelines on how States shall proceed to the administrative prosecution"
LČ36 (2015)	 Highlighted the need for a mechanism which could facilitate the transmission of information as regards infractions
	Emphasized that the implementation of A12 is not always effective
A40 2019)	 The lack of efficient and timely communication mechanisms between Aviation Authorities was identified among the reasons for the lack of efficiency
	• Establishment of the Article 12 Task Force following the inclusion of the Item "Processes and Procedures for States to fulfil their obligations under Article 12 of the Chicago Convention" to the
2021	General Work Programme of the Legal Committee by A40






Enforcement mechanisms when prosecuting a violation of the rules of the air




Percentage of States that have established laws or regulations for the implementation of Article 12

Article 12 (Rules of the Air)

Each contracting State undertakes to adopt measures to insure that every aircraft flying over or maneuvering within its territory and that every aircraft carrying its nationality mark, wherever such aircraft may be, shall comply with the rules and regulations relating to the flight and maneuver of aircraft there in force. Each contracting State undertakes to keep its own regulations in these respects uniform, to the greatest possible extent, with those established from time to time under this Convention. Over the high seas, the rules in force shall be those established under this Convention. Each contracting State undertakes to insure the prosecution of all persons violating the regulations applicable. (emphasis added)
