

The Levels of Travel Document Security Features

Guide Part 1, Section 6: Document Security



Level 1: Security features that can be seen with the unaided eye, without any specialized knowledge.



Level 2: Security features that can be seen using simple tools, such as a loupe or under UV light.



Level 3: The most sophisticated security features that require specialized knowledge and forensic equipment to locate and evaluate.
