

Advancing Accessibility: IATA's 4 pillars to remove barriers

- 1. Communication: Outreach the disability community
- 2. Advocacy: Consistent regulations and coordination
- **3. Processes:** Review of standards, procedures and new recommended practices
- 4. Services: Training and awareness raising

- In coordination with disability community and range of aviation stakeholders including regulators (CTA and TC).
- Examine and develop solutions in these areas:
- Rethink passenger and its mobility aid journey
- Support passengers with information along the travel chain
- Outlines for mobility devices handling training
- Job aids examples at booking, preparation, loading/ unloading and securing
