Express Delivery Services

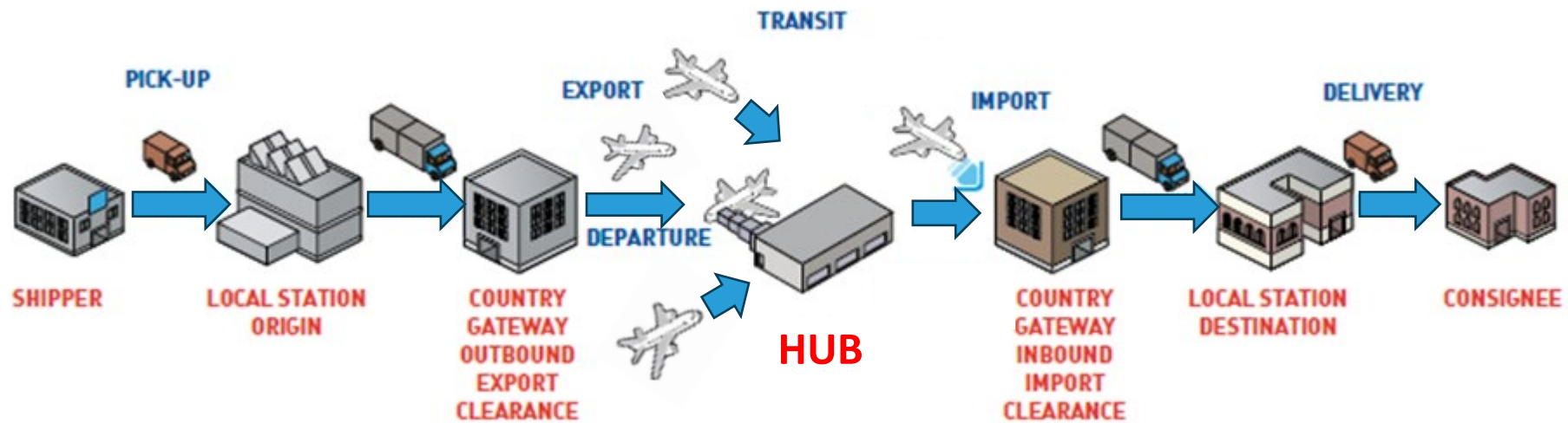
The fast conveyor belt of international trade

Multimodal, door-to door, time definite

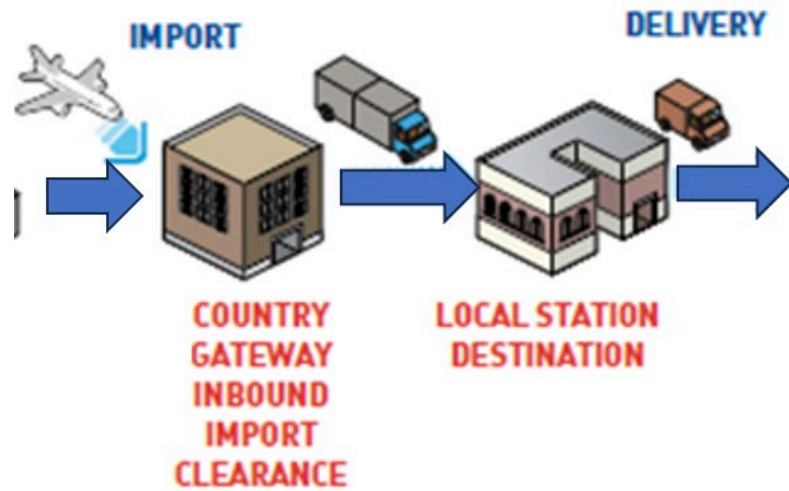


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Express Clearance

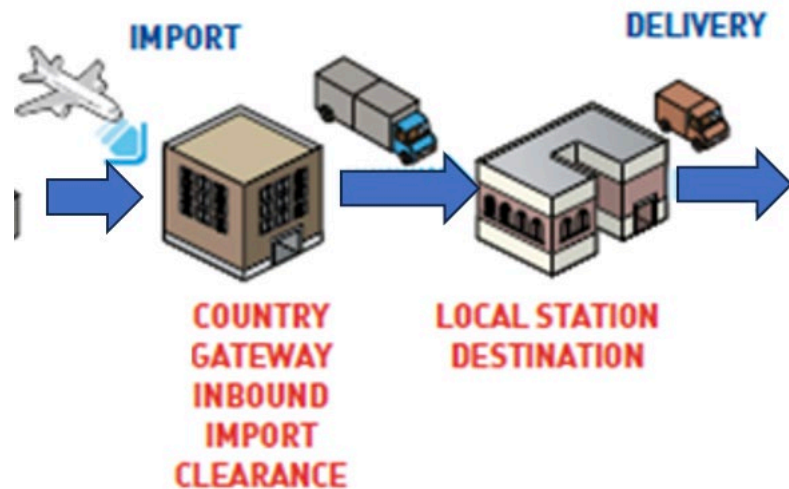
Best Practice / AIRPORT



- Night ops (hubs)
- Night flights (aircraft)
- Self-handling
- Own facility at airport
- Customs presence at facility

Express Clearance

Best Practice / **BORDER AGENCIES**



- No weight / value restriction
- Ability to receive and process electronic advance shipment data
 - 89/135 can
 - Paperless
 - Automated risk assessment
 - Release on arrival
 - Single window
- Separation of release & clearance
 - Cat 1 (docs), Cat 2 (de minimis) off manifest
 - Cat 3 (LVS), Cat 4 (HVS) 2-step declaration
- Adapted office hours
- Clearance at express facility
