


Growth as a data source





A comprehensive and trustworthy resource

The ICAO Public Key Directory is a centralized platform for **sharing public keys** needed to electronically verify travel documents.



The ICAO PKD contains data provided by programme participants.

More participants => More data shared

More data => Improved capacities for document verification


All data in the ICAO PKD is received based on provision of this data in a diplomatic handover

=> Value to document issuing authorities and border authorities based on comprehensiveness of trustworthy data

Majority of Passports are ePassports

• >160 States issuing ePassports

• c. 90% of passports in circulation are ePassports





Appropriate use of the ePassport relies on validation of the digital signature using PKI



Authenticity

Issuance by genuine authority

Integrity

 Data hasn't been changed since issuance (including the facial image)

A needed resource

ICAO Annex 9

3.9.3 Recommended Practice.— Contracting States implementing checks on eMRTDs at border controls should join the ICAO PKD and use the information available from the PKD to validate eMRTDs at border controls.

The majority of checks at many borders will be on ePassports (eMRTDs).

=> Value to border authorities based on availability of data needed for the majority of border checks



- **ICAO Master List** introduced in 2020 provides the root of trust CSCA certificate for ALL electronic and digital documents
- Barcode Signer Certificates for all Barcode types can be shared since 2023

- ⇒ Value to document issuers based on sharing of data for a variety of document types
- ⇒ **Value** for border authorities based on **flexibility** to **verify different documents** from international issuers



⇒ **Value** to national border authorities based on **fundamental importance in automating checks** and obtaining associated benefits





A basis for agility in border processes

Pivoting to new digital formats and processes

The ICAO Health Master List was quickly implemented through the ICAO PKD to provide the data needed to verify digital health credentials presented during travel BUT

Quick and proper use required existing national infrastructure and capabilities

- ⇒ Connect to and Use the PKD NOW
- ⇒ Become **resilient** to situations needing updated processes, issuance of or verification of new credentials LATER
 - ⇒ **Value** to national authorities that may need an international distribution mechanism for new public keys in crisis situations
 - ⇒ **Value** to national border authorities who can quickly **pivot** processes and capabilities to new needs **when the PKD** is part of the existing back-end infrastructure
