

#### **Coordination mechanisms**

- Development of the ESPII healthcare protocol
- Creation of inter-institutional committees for joint decision-making
- Definition of roles, responsibilities, and competencies contributing to the same goal
- Establishment of efficient communication channels
- Implementation of adjustment and continuous improvement mechanisms



## **Surpassed Challenges in Covid-19**

- Resolution of disagreements between different entities.
- Development of capacity to adapt to restriction measures based on new scientific evidence.
- Keep the response staff motivated in a high-pressure environment.
- Finding a balance between public health measures and the economic impact of port restrictions among actors
- Develop capacity for testing and tracing travelers despite the large volume that would allow the early detection of cases and contact tracing.

### Challenges that require an intersectoral approach


- Implement customized and efficient control measures for the high volume of people and goods moving through ports
- Propose risk-based surveillance that allows efforts to be focused on products, destinations and populations that present a greater risk of introducing emerging and reemerging diseases
- Strengthen international cooperation, as a fundamental element to share information, experiences and best practices in port surveillance
- Aim to develop technologies for coordination that improve efficiency, collaboration, and decision-making. Example: Online platforms, document management, real-time communication, artificial intelligence, chatbots, virtual assistants, predictive analytics, internet of things, virtual reality for simulators that recreate complex scenarios
- Raise awareness among travelers to share truthful information for follow-up
