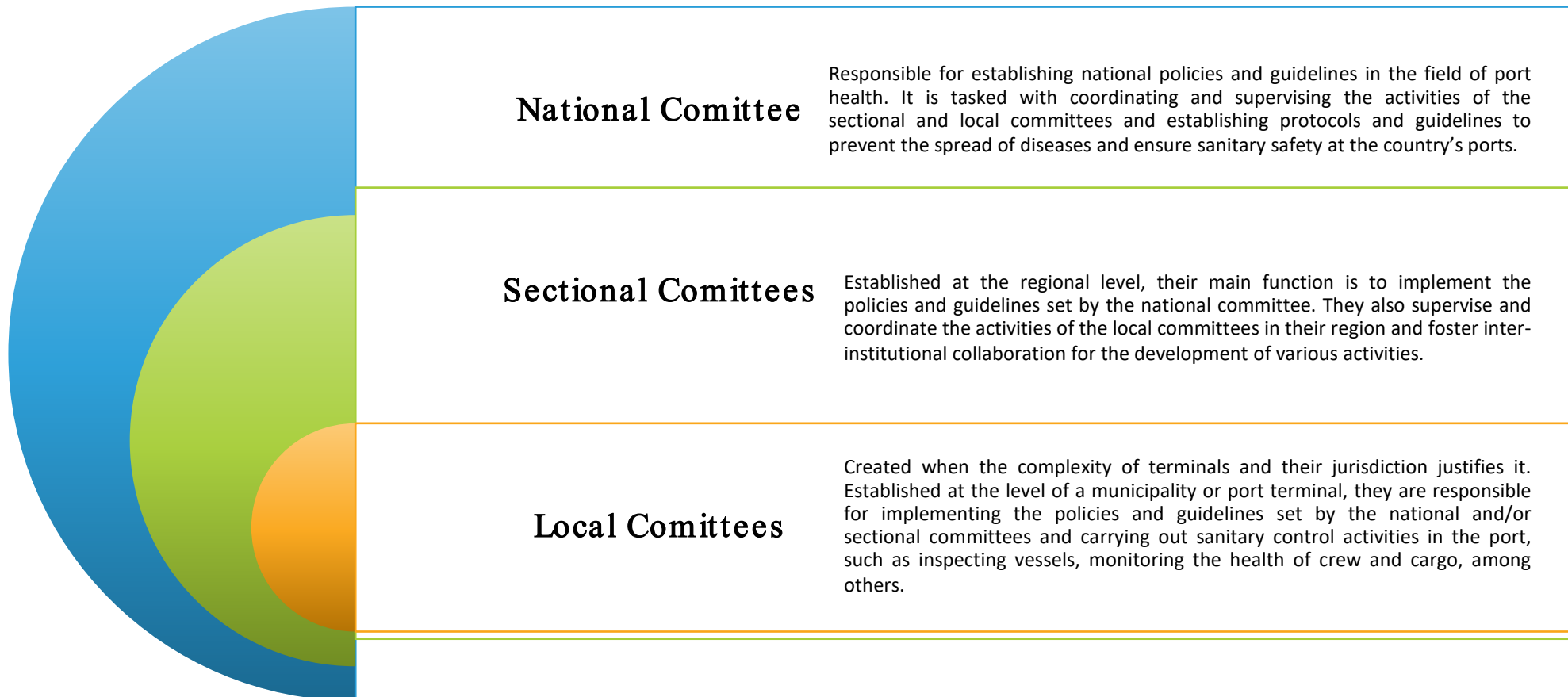

All public and private entities involved in national and international traffic, with the aim of ensuring the protection of public health and the agricultural, livestock, and renewable natural resources.

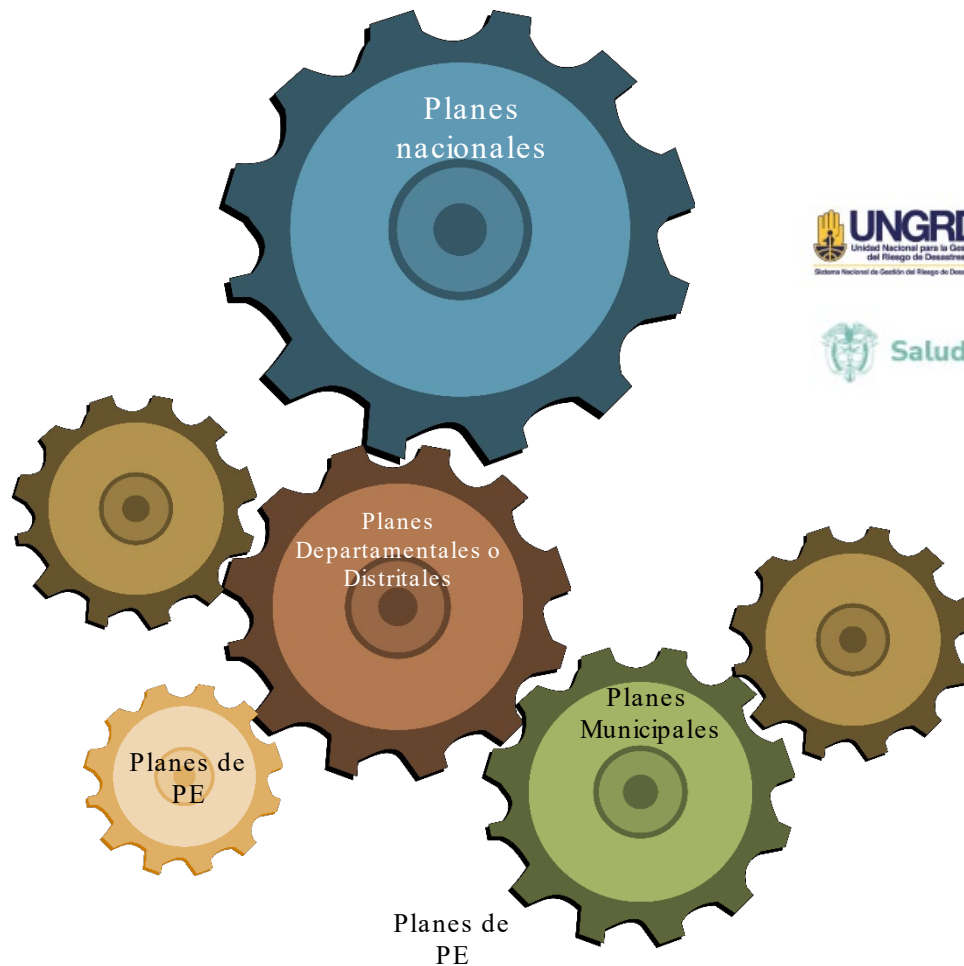


Contingency and Emergency Plans



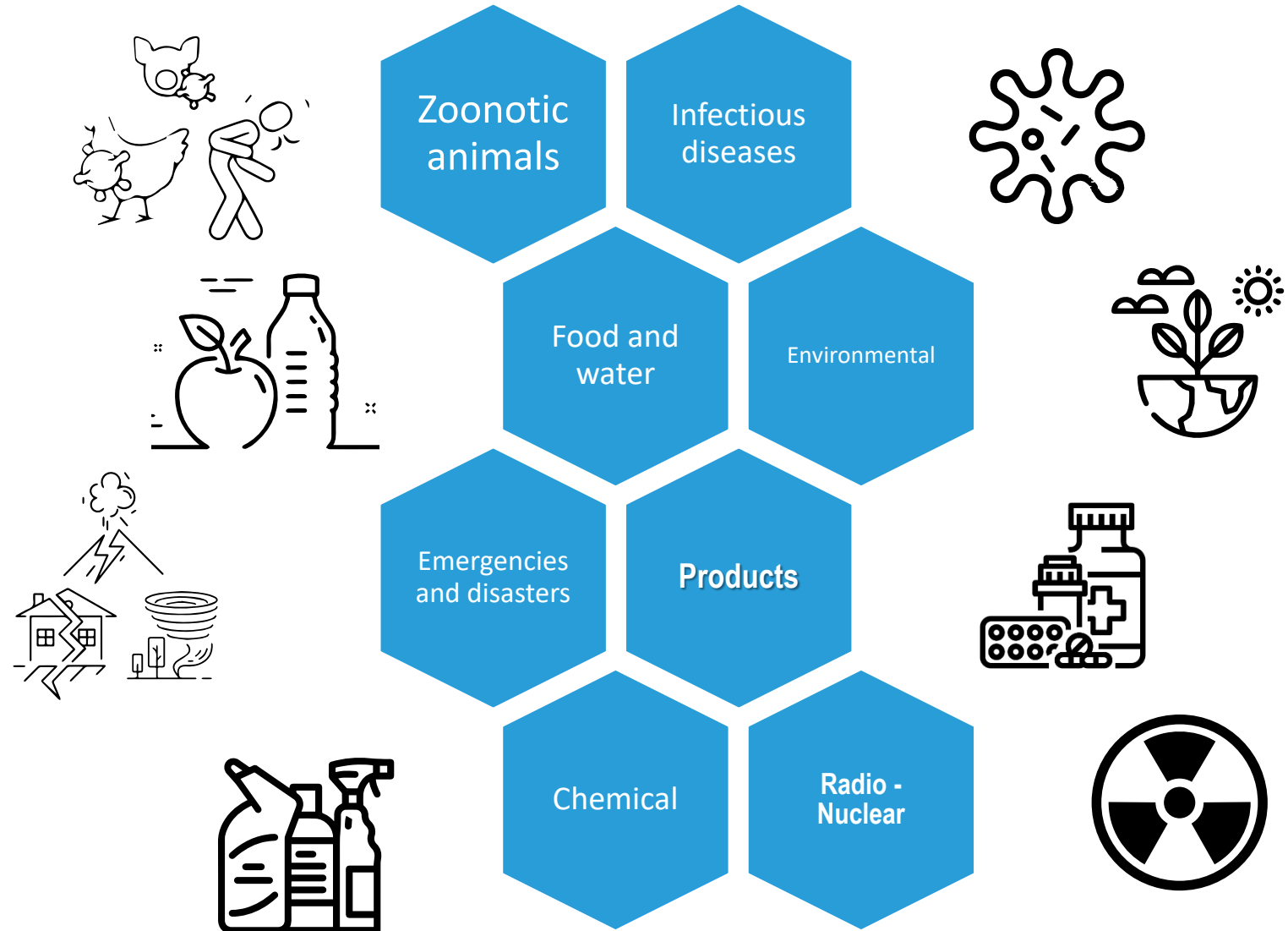
To respond promptly and in a coordinated manner to public health events detected at points of entry, identifying the associated risks to ensure conditions that mitigate, control, and prevent their spread.

Coordination of national, departmental, district, and municipal plans



- ✓ The emergency plans of points of entry are aligned with those of their respective municipalities or districts, departments, and in turn with the national plans.
- ✓ Characterize the installed capacity of health service providers within their jurisdiction, which must be considered in the entry point emergency plans.
