4. VISA INFORMATION

eVISA is applicable for foreigners who require a visa to enter Malaysia. Delegates from the following countries can apply for an eVISA for tourist:

Notes:

- Starting from 1st December 2023 until 31st December 2024, **eVISA for Tourist is NOT required for P.R China and India nationals ONLY** travelling to Malaysia for tour purposes (Single Entry Visa).
- eVISA can be applied around the world **EXCEPT Malaysia, Israel and North Korea**.
- For countries marked with an asterisk (*), delegates are allowed to enter Malaysia by air only.
- Israeli citizens who wish to enter Malaysia are required to obtain a visa and approval from the Ministry of Home Affairs of Malaysia.
- Visa is not required for a stay of less than one (1) month for ASEAN nationals except Myanmar. Visa is required for a duration of stay that exceeds one (1) month, except for Brunei and Singapore nationals.

Information on passports that require a visa before entry, visa procedure (payment and documents to submit), and duration of visa validity is also available on the website.

5. MALAYSIA DIGITAL ARRIVAL CARD

Delegates are required to complete the Malaysia Digital Arrival Card (MDAC) three (3) days prior to arrival, except:

- i. Citizens of Singapore;
- ii. Diplomatic and Official Passport holders;
- iii. Malaysian Permanent Residents and Long Term-Pass holders;
- iv. General Certificate of Identity (GCI) Brunei Darussalam holders;
- v. Brunei Malaysia Frequent Traveller Facility holders;
- vi. Thailand Border Pass holders; and
- vii. Indonesia Cross-Border Travel Document (PLB) holders.

6. YELLOW FEVER VACCINATION CERTIFICATE

A Yellow Fever vaccination certificate is required from all visitors or delegates (Malaysians and foreigners) coming from or going to/through countries with risk of Yellow Fever transmission¹ (as stated in the International Health Regulations 2005 and Prevention and Control of Infectious Disease Act 1988) as listed below:

Yellow fever vaccination is also required for travellers having transited more than 12 hours through the airport of a country with risk of yellow fever transmission.

Travellers or delegates without a valid Yellow Fever vaccination certificate shall be quarantined upon arrival in Malaysia for a period not exceeding 6 days.

7. WEATHER

In October, the west coast temperatures average around 29°C (84.2°F), while Kuala Lumpur is slightly cooler at 27°C (80.6°F).

8. TIME ZONE

Malaysian Standard Time (MST) is the official time for Malaysia which is Coordinated Universal Time (UTC) plus eight hours (UTC+8).

9. CURRENCY AND PAYMENT

The currency in Malaysia is the Malaysian Ringgit (MYR). Currency exchange services are available at Kuala Lumpur International Airport.

Payment cards, such as credit cards and debit cards, are widely accepted in Malaysia. Please note that some stalls or smaller shops prefer cash payment in Malaysian Ringgit.

Currency exchange rates are based on the current rates by the Central Bank of Malaysia. As of 17 May 2024:

1 USD = MYR 4.6850
1 GBP = MYR 5.9305
1 EUR = MYR 5.0874

10. ELECTRICITY SUPPLY

In Malaysia, power plugs and sockets (outlets) of type G (rectangular three-pin plug) are used. The standard voltage is 240 volts at a frequency of 50 Hz. Delegates from other countries with different electricity standards will need a plug adapter to use their devices in Malaysia.



11. INTERNATIONAL DIALING CODE

Worldwide direct connections are available, using the international code or telephone operator as necessary. From outside Malaysia, dial +60 followed by the area code (for landline numbers) and the required number.

Mobile telephone services are quite efficient in Malaysia. Some of the main mobile telephone service providers are: Maxis, Celcom, Digi and U-Mobile. Mobile telephone service providers also provide gateway to internet using 4G and 5G.

Mobile phone SIM cards are easily available at the range of USD3-USD10. Delegates should note that registration is required for activation.

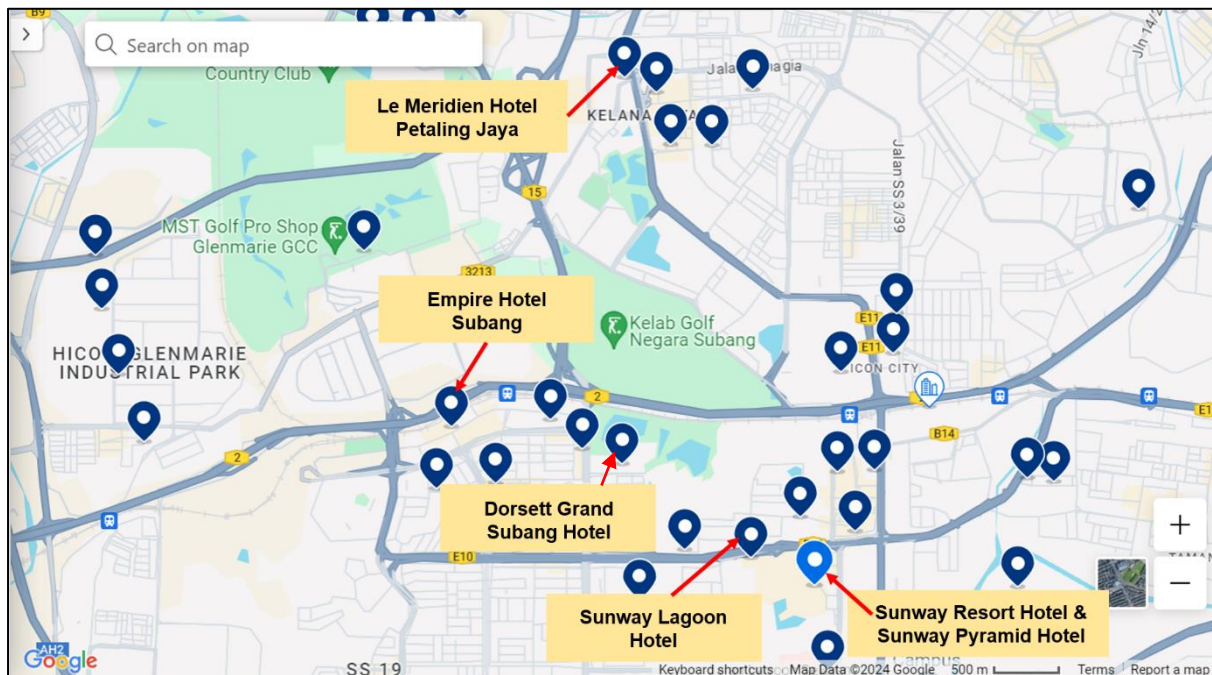

14. AIRPORT TRANSFERS

Transportation options are available to Sunway Resort Hotel from Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA) Terminal 1 and Terminal 2. Delegates may book a taxi service or opt for e-hailing service at the airport. It is approximately a 50-minutes journey and fares vary during non-peak and peak hours.

Alternatively, delegates may also get to the hotel by other public transportation. Delegates may take the KLIA Ekspres train service from KLIA Terminal 1 or Terminal 2 which goes directly to KL Sentral. From there, delegates can take the Putra Light Rail Transit (LRT) Kelana Jaya line (towards Putra Heights) to the USJ 7 Station as your destination. Then, transfer to the Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) Sunway line (towards Sunway-Setia Jaya) to the Sunway Lagoon Station. Sunway Resort Hotel is directly connected to the station.

15. HEALTH SERVICES

A medical bay will be made available at the event venue should delegates require immediate medical attention. However, in case of emergency medical care, it is advisable for delegates to have a valid travel/health insurance coverage for the duration of their stay in Malaysia.
