ANNEX 9: International Legal Reference – Each Contracting State Shall:

- **8.17** Establish a National Air Transport Facilitation Program based on the facilitation requirements of the Convention and of Annex 9.
- **8.18** Ensure that the objective of its NATFP shall be to adopt all practicable measures to facilitate the movement of aircraft, crews, passengers, cargo, mail and stores by removing unnecessary obstacles and delays.

ANNEX 9: International Legal Reference – Each Contracting State Shall:

8.19 Establish a National Air Transport Facilitation Committee for the purpose of coordinating and facilitating activities between departments, agencies and other organizations of the State concerned with, or responsible for various aspects of international civil aviation as well as with airport and aircraft operations.
