






Capability to verify all ICAO digital and electronic documents – ePassports, eID, DTC, barcodes...

Repository of BCSCs




Barcode Signer Certificates associated with ICAO Digitally Signed Barcodes

Root of Trust (CA) public key certificates from global authorities



The PKD Strategy 2023-2025

1. Executive Summary

The PKD Strategy is intended to provide a conceptual framework to guide PKD membership decision-making related to current and future investments and activities aimed at setting the course for the PKD's growth over the 2023-25 cycle. The Strategy is comprised of four conceptual pillars intended to organize various current and future activities/initiatives.

The PKD Strategy's four pillars are as follows:

- Build the offering in terms of content and service, while enhancing ease of Use;
- Ensure that the PKD can support future development of globally interoperable solutions;
- Ensuring proper use of the PKD by all participants in a complete and timely manner; and
- Grow participation amongst all who can benefit from the PKD, including governments and private sector entities.

New ICAO PKD System from 2026


Further Fulfilling Strategic Goals for Advancement

- 1. Integration of existing services Migrating the Health Master List to the same platform as the ICAO PKD for travel documents and managing all with the same systems and approach (the HML is currently managed on separate systems)
- 2. Flexibility for further development openness technically and financially to flexibly add new data types, sources, purposes and uses (travel, health, wider aviation...?)
- 3. Improved user offering addition of intuitive web services for more seamless and convenient use and enhanced reporting, statistical analysis, automation etc.
- 4. Enhanced provisions for user support from the ICAO Secretariat, the PKD operator and the wider PKD community
