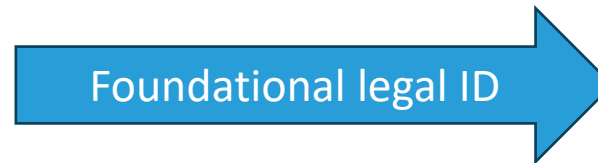

Unregistered populations: A loss to both sectors

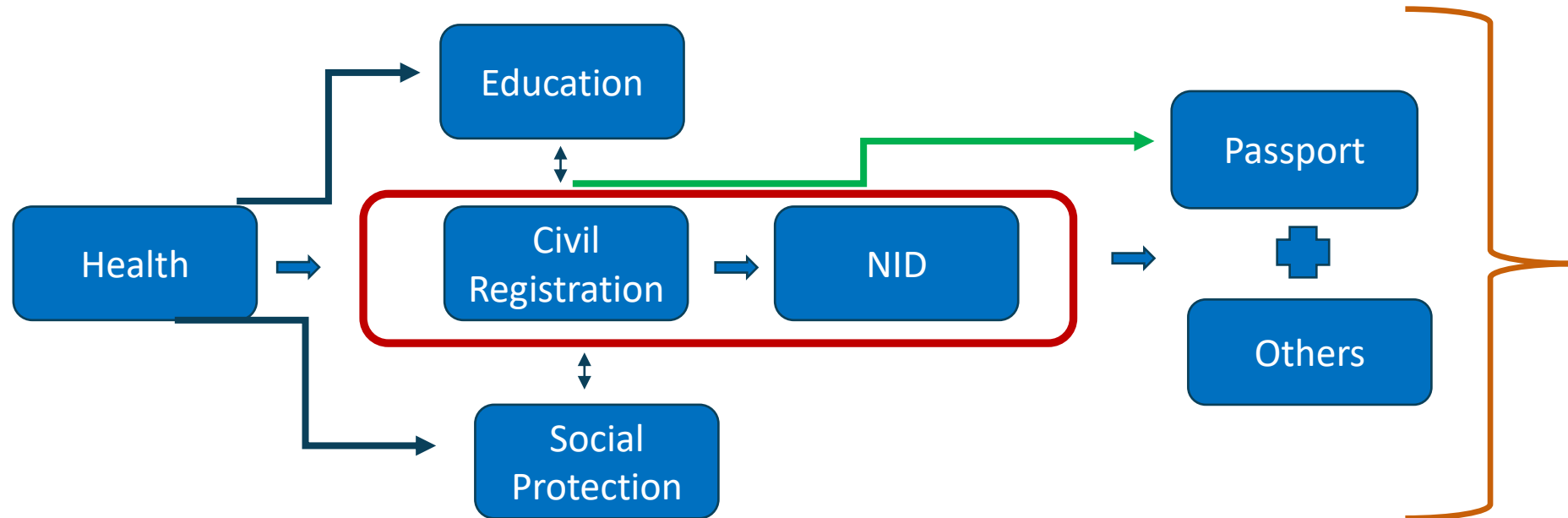
Single Source of Truth – what and why

Basic characteristics of an individual's identity

Name, sex, date of birth, place of birth, parentage

DPI

Why is it still so hard to keep basic data fields accurate and consistent across systems?

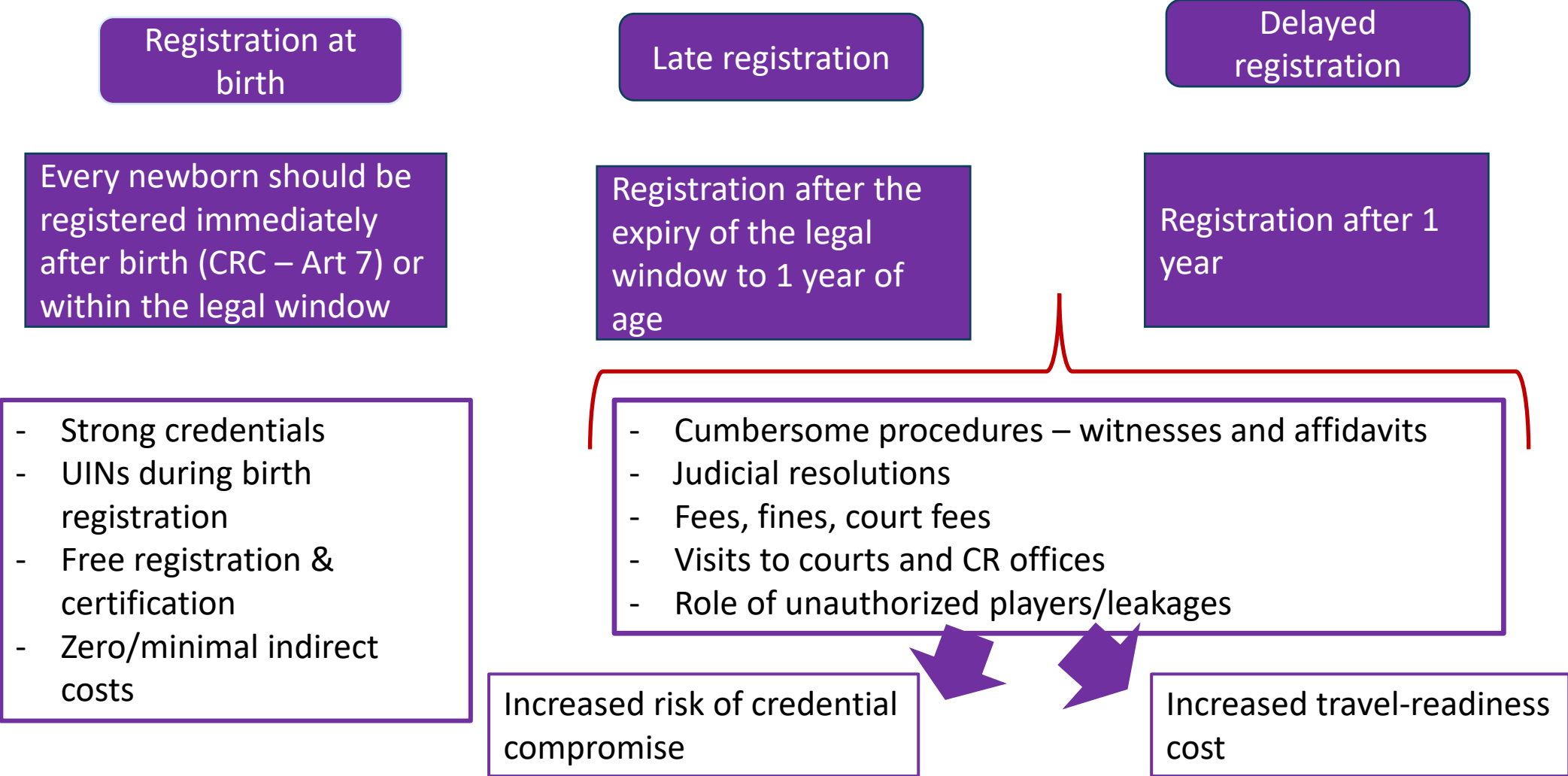


- Unharmonized data standards
- Non-availability of individual level data
- Insufficient & inappropriate digitalization
- Systemic flaws
- Left-out populations and many more...

Every system flaw or gap is a threat to legal identity and travel documents

Why registration at birth is an indispensable necessity?



Consequences of variations in key data fields

Three real-life examples

Name was different in the birth certificate and the school leaving certificate

Birth was registered with his nickname

Class X certificate had the proper name

Difference stalled his passport application

RBD ACT doesn't allow change in name

Despite a court order, it took him 6 months to get the amended birth certificate

Name as well as date of birth was different in the birth certificate and the school leaving certificate

The case was similar to the previous one, but the date of birth was also different – there was a difference of one year

The court agreed to the name change, but rejected the request for the date of birth change

After 1 year or so, he got the passport but with the dob as per his birth certificate

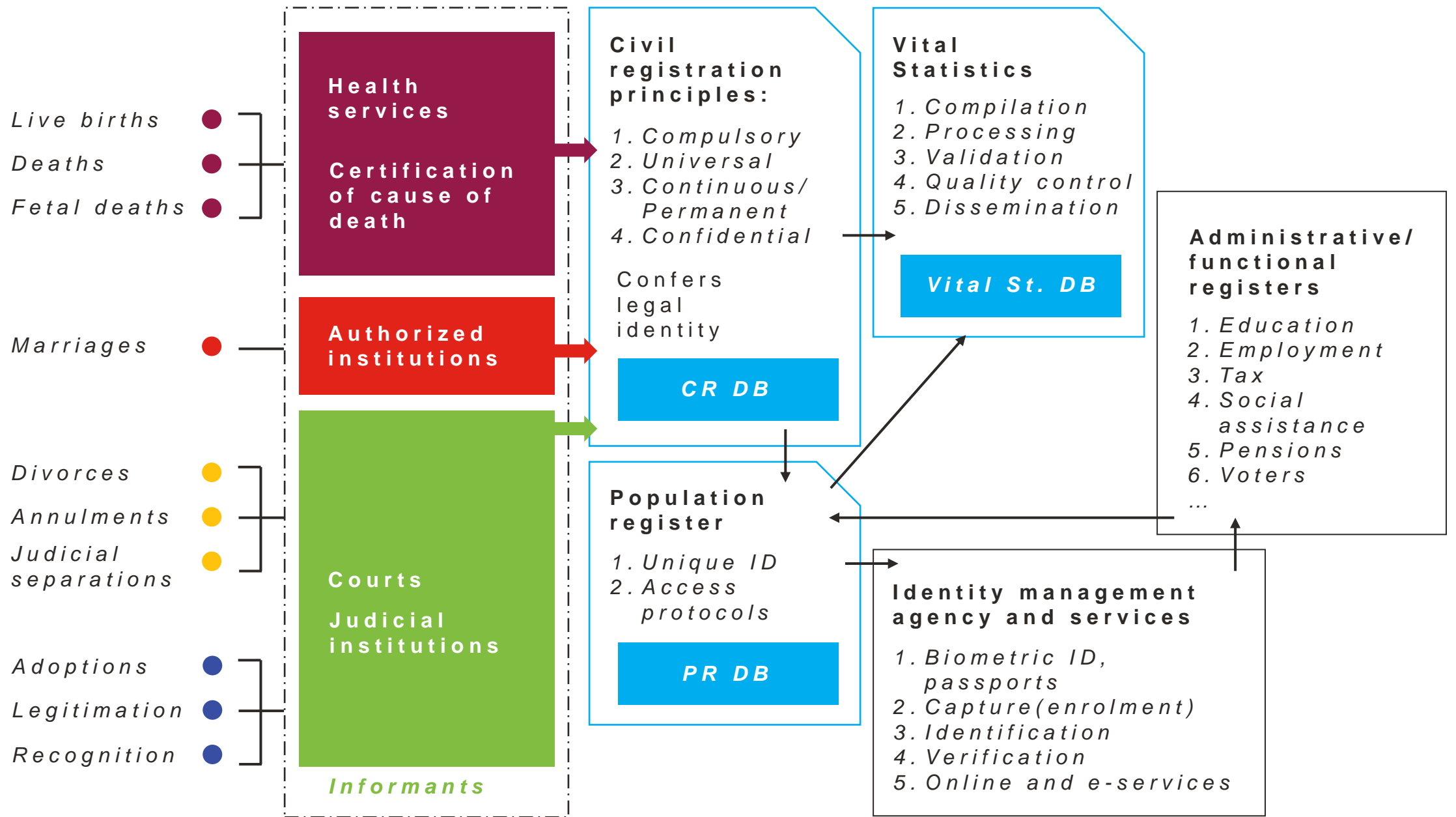


One of the best data entry operators

Got an opportunity for a UNICEF internship in another country

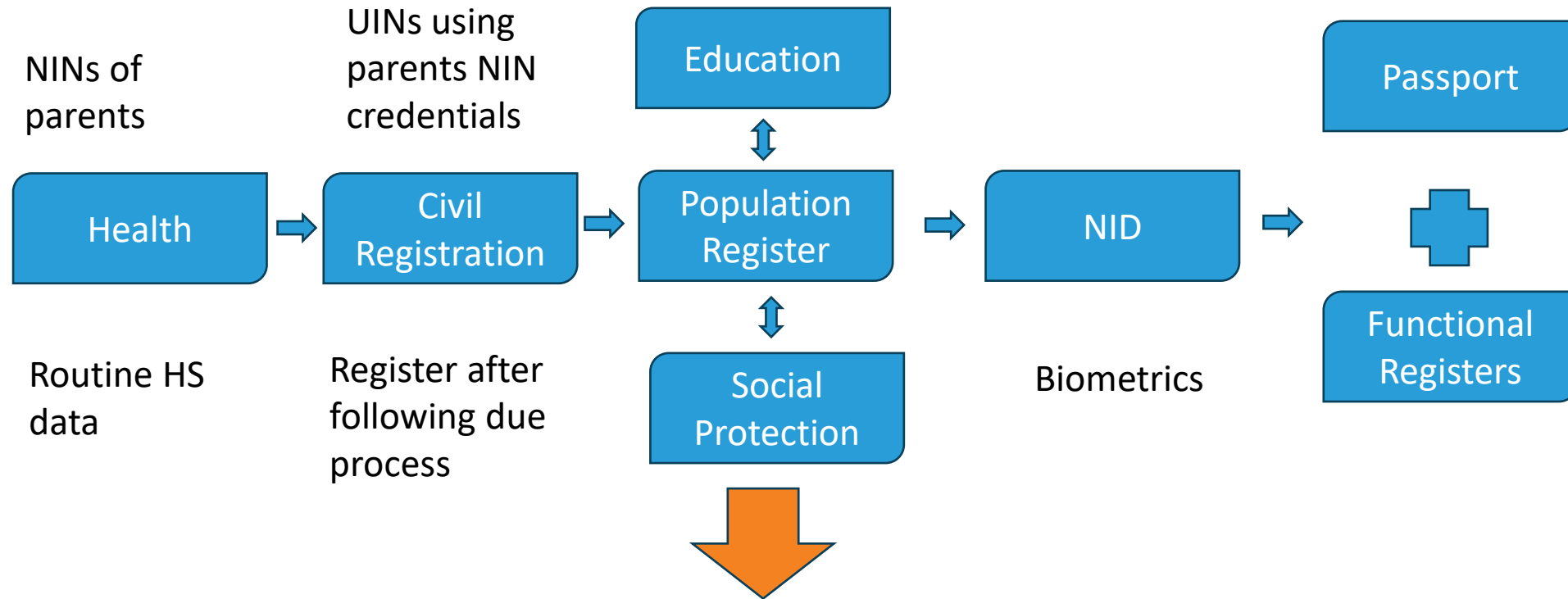
Missed the opportunity as she didn't have a birth certificate, a must for the passport

Took 2 more years to get her birth registered as she was a 3rd gen. stateless and didn't have proof of birth



Health –CR –National ID – Passport pathway – a way forward

DPI



Collect information once, use it multiple times

Enable tracking changes, if any, where and when

Move information, not people

CRVS and ID management is critical for the overall ID ecosystem

A single source of truth for under-18 cohort

Under 5

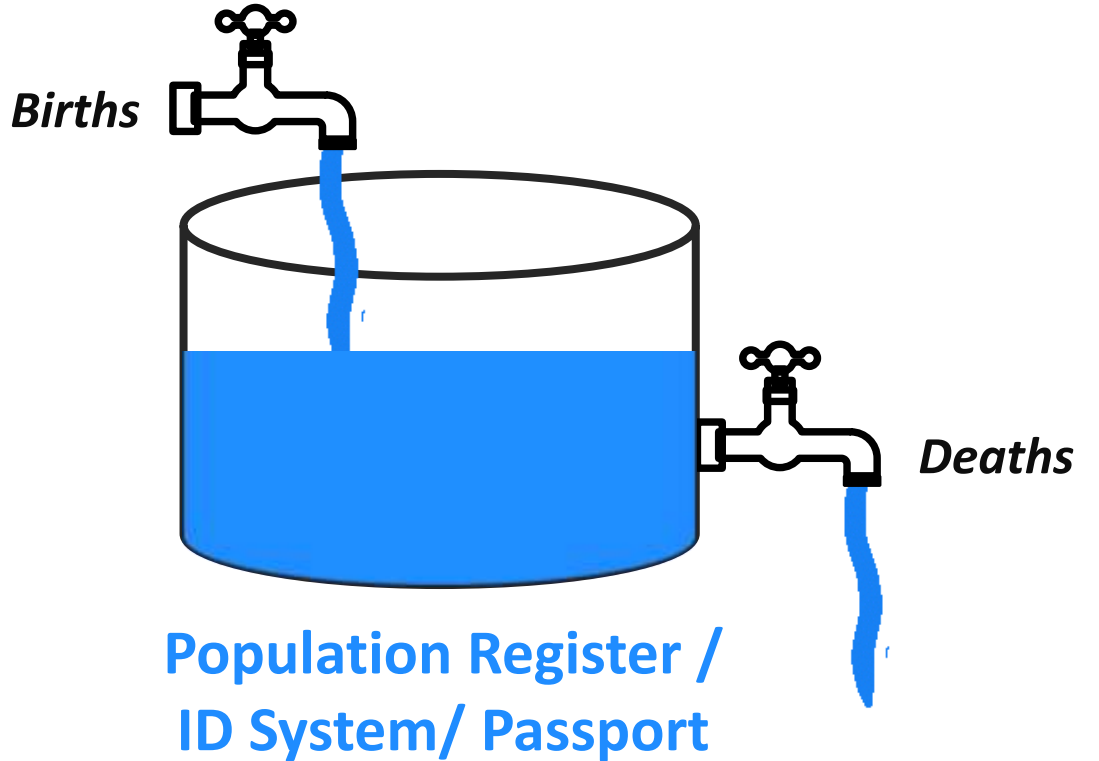
Birth registration compulsory for UINs/NINs

5-17

Verify the status of birth registrations and provide the necessary information to the civil registration authorities for any unregistered children

It will ultimately cover all age groups

Linking birth and death registration with ID system



Retiring identity is essential to prevent its misuse

Three takeaways

Ensuring the integrity of travel documents is closely connected to maintaining data integrity in Health, CRVS, and NID Systems

Greater and sustained investments are essential across systems to enhance

- Standardization

- Digitalization

- Interoperability

- Data privacy and Security

- Inter-agency collaboration
