As a result of the First North American, Central American and Caribbean Working Group (NACC/WG) Surveillance Task Force (SURV/TF/01) Meeting, held online on 24 May 2024, after analyzing the works carried out to date on the implementation of Automatic Dependent Surveillance – Broadcast (ADS-B), and considering GREPECAS/21 Conclusion that was requested to create a work plan for the implementation of ADS-B and present it at the GREPECAS/22 meeting, Mr. Jaime Abigantus is invited to a face-to-face meeting from 30 to 31 July 2024 at the ICAO NACC Regional Office.

This meeting will be held in Spanish only with the attendance of representatives from Cuba, Dominican Republic, Mexico, and COCESNA, all of them under the process of ADS-B implementation. The meeting will have the support from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA), United States.

The objective of the meeting is to act on the implementation of ADS-B in the CAR Region's upper airspace, taking advantage of the surveillance infrastructure that these participating States/Organizations already have in place. In this regard, it's necessary that IATA, as airlines' representative, provide information on its use and actions needed to complete before implementing the regulation of the operation of the ADS-B in the region.
