1. Introduction

- 1.1. The Twentieth Meeting of the Caribbean and South America Regional Planning and Implementation Group (GREPECAS/20) approved the initial version 0 of Volume III of the CAR/SAM Air Navigation Plan (ANP), formulated based on the ICAO Council Template, and aligned with recommendation of the AN-Conf 13. Subsequently, GREPECAS/21 approved version 0.1 of Volume III of the CAR/SAM ANP¹, incorporating data and information from States and airports in the CAR Region.
- 1.2. However, Volume III of the CAR/SAM ANP is not complete and requires extensive planning to enhance the capacity and efficiency of aerodrome operations. This involves calculating GANP Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) related to aerodromes, as well as developing investment and development plans for the short, medium, and long term based on the six-step method for performance-based planning.

2. Discussion
