Dear Sir/Madam, Esteemed colleagues,

For several years, the ICAO NACC Regional Office has maintained an ambitious support Programme for the Eastern Caribbean, prioritizing regional approaches such as the strengthening of the civil aviation authority for the Organization of Eastern Caribbean States (OECS), the Eastern Caribbean Civil Aviation Authority (ECCAA), as well as the Caribbean Aviation Safety and Security Oversight System (CASSOS). You have my renewed commitment to support the States of the Eastern Caribbean.

Building upon eight years of experience working with this region in my previous role, since I have taken office as the NACC Regional Director, I have witnessed the ongoing challenges the States of the Eastern Caribbean face in complying with the international Standards and Recommended Practices (SARPs) established by ICAO in different areas, as well as the limitations to provide air navigation services by relatively small organizations, maintaining the levels of services expected by users. I have noted your comments regarding the need to maintain and expand the support provided to this subregion, tailoring more specifically to your needs and operational context, to ensure that the capacities in your States are developed to allow sustainable compliance with the ICAO SARPs and industry best practices.

In this regard, I have made the decision to implement a renewed emphasis on the Eastern Caribbean, which will foster a closer relationship between the NACC Regional Office and entities responsible for aviation safety and security oversight and the providers of air navigation, meteorology, and other services that are essential for the continuity and regularity of air transport in this subregion by promoting the development of specific projects that facilitate the use of available resources, avoiding duplication of efforts, and coordinating with potential donors on concrete proposals.

In the short term, this renewed emphasis will be evidenced by the re-establishment of inperson meetings for the main air navigation implementation subregional working groups, the Eastern Caribbean Civil Aviation Technical Group (E/CAR/CATG) and the Eastern Caribbean Network Technical Group (E/CAR/NTG). For a more in-depth action plan, our team will conduct an initial assessment of the projects and initiatives currently being implemented, or in the last planning phase in your States to develop comprehensive projects that complement those activities, providing additional assistance as required.

One important aspect worth mentioning is the partnership approach proposed by the revised NACC Strategic Assistance Programme (SAP), where high-level political commitment and sustained technical support will be required from your States, as agreed during the last North American,

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Central American and Caribbean Directors of Civil Aviation (NACC/DCA) Meeting. We will follow up with concrete ideas on how to put this new concept into action.

I hope this letter serves to reiterate our commitment to your States in support of the goals established by ICAO and to strengthen our ties of cooperation, joint work and collaboration to promote the socio-economic development of your States by meeting the expectations of our main stakeholders.

Accept, Sir/Madam, the assurances of my highest consideration.




