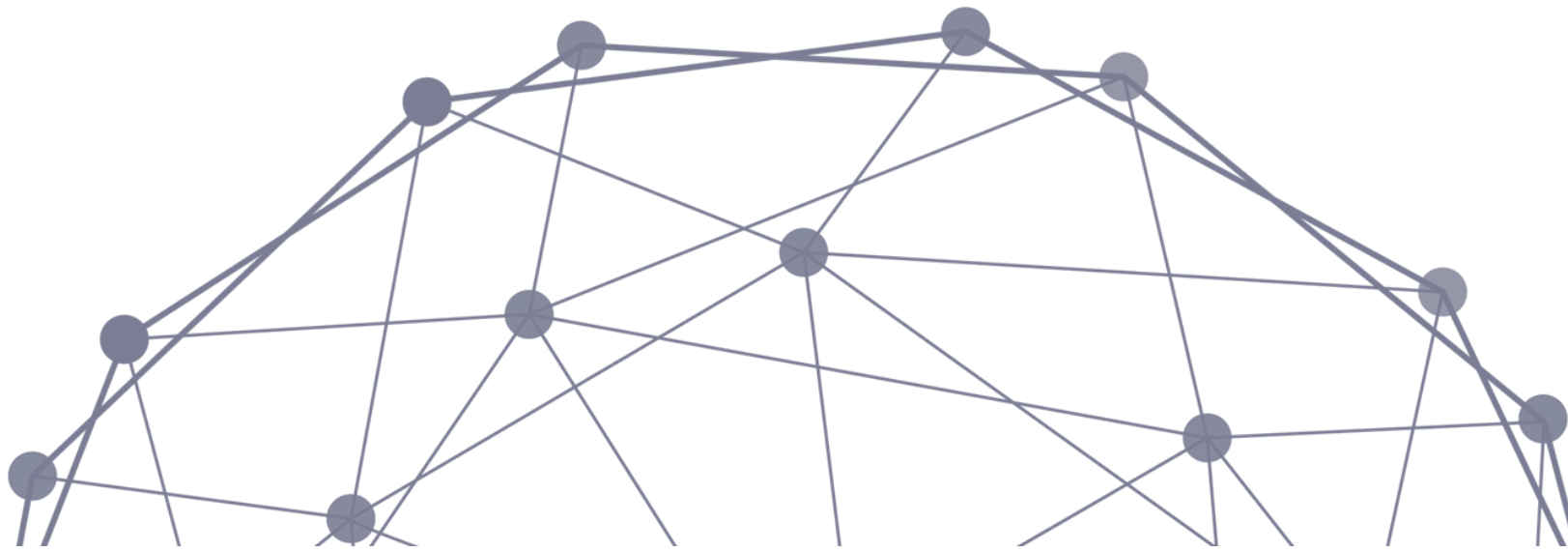

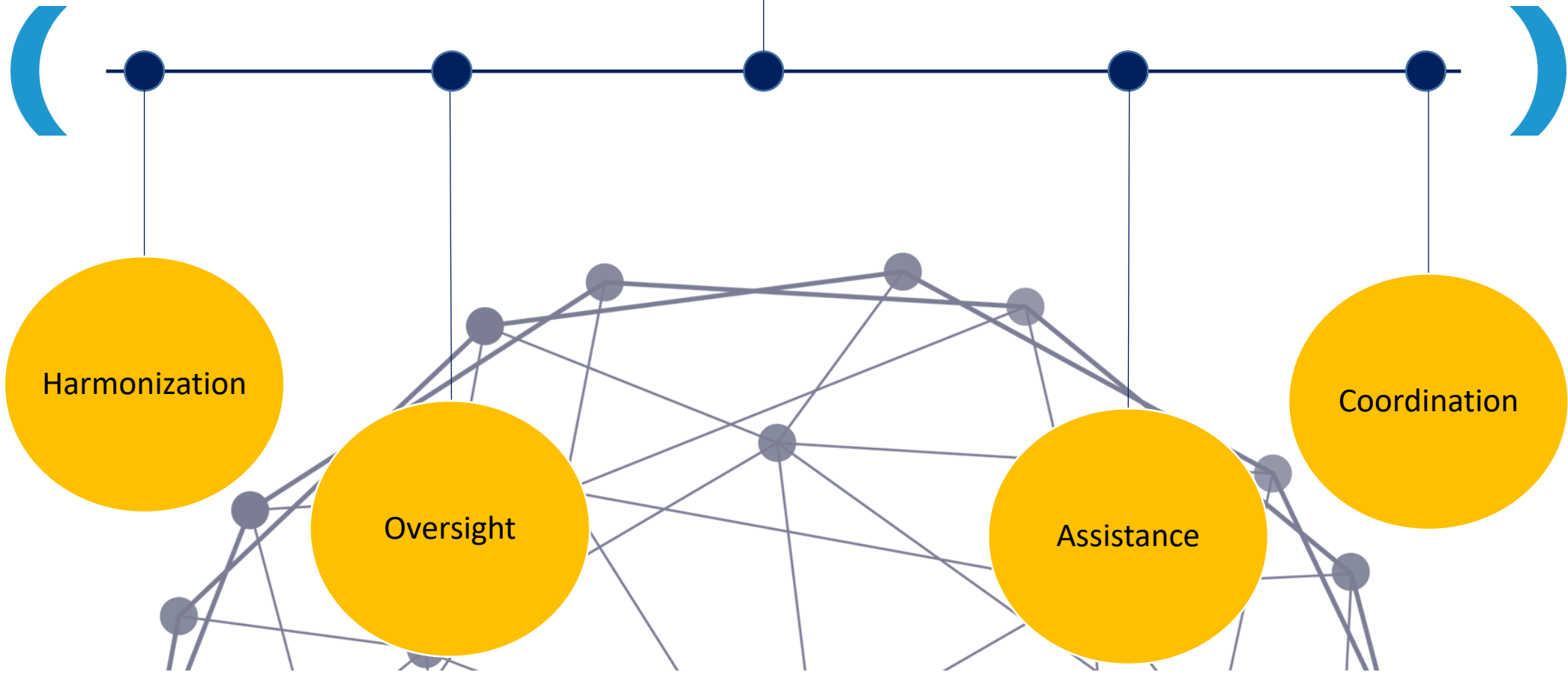


Introduction

- **Definition:** Regional Safety Oversight Organizations (RSOOs) are regional bodies responsible for overseeing aviation safety within a defined geographical area.
- **Purpose:** To ensure uniform safety standards and regulatory compliance across its member states.



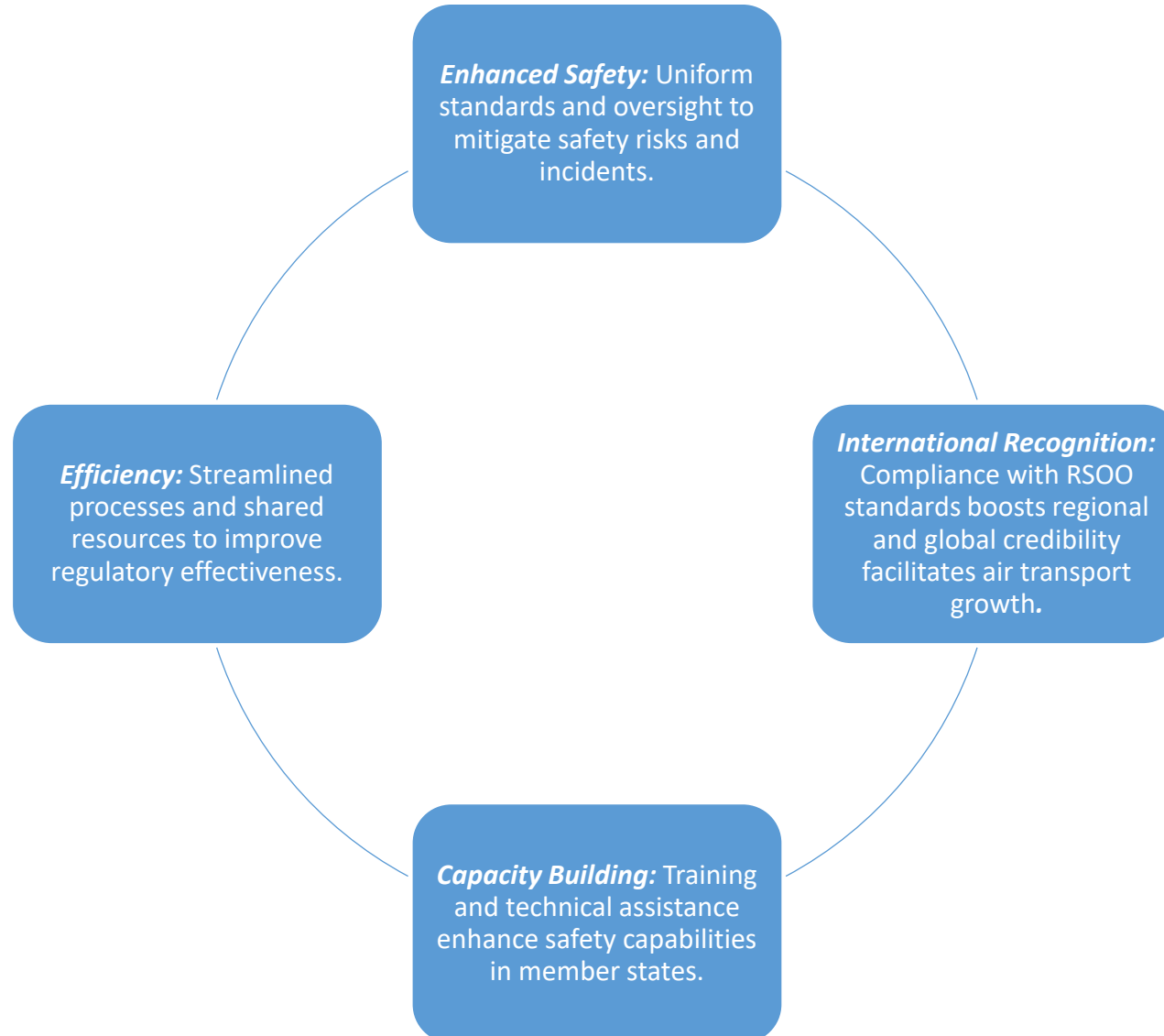
Key functions of RSOOs



Key functions of RSOOs

- ✓ **Harmonization:** The establishment of common safety regulations and practices among its member states.
- ✓ **Oversight:** To monitor compliance with international safety standards (ICAO, FAA).
- ✓ **Assistance:** To provide technical support and capacity building to enhance safety capabilities.
- ✓ **Coordination:** To facilitate collaboration among member states, airlines, and aviation stakeholders.

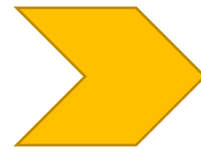
