Capacity Building for SAF eligible under CORSIA

ICAO project funded by the EU

- At the 41st session of ICAO Assembly (2022), the EU announced a **EUR 1.6 million** funding to support SAF capacity building in **10 States**, with a focus on **India** and **Africa**.
- In December 2023, ICAO and the European Commission signed a Grant Contract, establishing a clear framework for the project.
- Objective of the project: to contribute to the mitigation of CO2 emissions from international civil aviation in 10 ICAO States by implementing capacity building activities in the form of **feasibility studies that will support the future development of SAF eligible under CORSIA**.



All States meet the following criteria

- ✓ Joined ICAO's ACT-SAF programme (Mauritania in the process of joining)
- ✓ Requested a SAF feasibility study
- ✓ Submitted a State Action Plan (Mauritania will receive support in 2024)
- ✓ Indication of feedstock availability

Proposal for 10th State: Madagascar

- ✓ Meets all above criteria
- ✓ Expressed strong interest to receive a feasibility study.

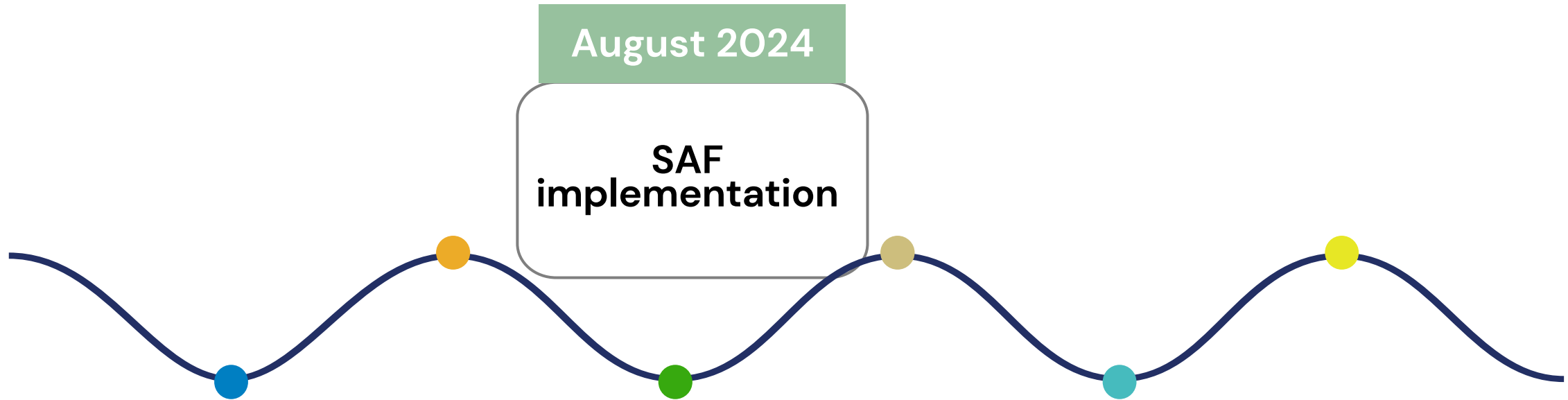


The following timeline is proposed for carrying out all feasibility studies

- 2024: Ethiopia, India and South Africa
- 2025: Egypt, Mauritania, Cameroun and Equatorial Guinea
- 2026: Senegal, Mozambique and Madagascar
