Capacity Building for SAF eligible under CORSIA ICAO project funded by the EU



The project at a glance



- At the 41st session of ICAO Assembly (2022), the EU announced a **EUR 1.6 million** funding to support SAF capacity building in **10 States**, with a focus on **India** and **Africa**.
- In December 2023, ICAO and the European Commission signed a Grant Contract, establishing a clear framework for the project.
- Objective of the project: to contribute to the mitigation of CO2 emissions from international civil aviation in 10 ICAO States by implementing capacity building activities in the form of feasibility studies that will support the future development of SAF eligible under CORSIA.





Selection of States



All States meet the following criteria

- Joined ICAO's ACT-SAF programme (Mauritania in the process of joining)
- Requested a SAF feasibility study
- Submitted a State Action Plan(Mauritania will receive support in 2024)
- ✓ Indication of feedstock availability

Proposal for 10th State: Madagascar

- Meets all above criteria
- Expressed strong interest to receive a feasibility study.





Proposed overall timeline




The following timeline is proposed for carrying out all feasibility studies

- 2024: Ethiopia, India and South Africa
- 2025: Egypt, Mauritania,Cameroun and Equatorial Guinea
- 2026: Senegal, Mozambique and Madagascar
