Twenty Third Ordinary Meeting of the General Board

(Cartagena de Indias, Colombia, 26 July 2011)

GENERAL INFORMATION

(Presented by the Secretariat)

1. Place and date

The Twenty Third Ordinary Meeting of the General Board of the Regional Safety Oversight Cooperation System (JG/23), will be held in Cartagena de Indias, Colombia, on 26 July 2011, at the Las Américas Resort y Centro de Convenciones Hotel.

2. **Registration of participants**

Registration of participants will take place at the site of the event on Tuesday 26 July 2011, from 08:30 to 09:00 hours. Participants are requested to fill in the registration form and submit it duly completed to mail@lima.icao.int and confirm their data at the registration desk.

3. **Opening session**

Tuesday 26 July 2011

Opening session: 09:00 hrs

Place: Las Américas Resort and Centro de Convenciones Hotel.

4. **Documentation**

The documentation for the meeting will be posted on the ICAO SAM Regional Office website http://www.lima.icao.int/ Participants should check the website frequently to download the documentation.

5. Arrival and transportation

International airlines that flight to Cartagena de Indias arrive at Aeropuerto Internacional Rafael Núñez, located in the urban perimeter allowing easy access to any place in the city. The host hotel offers airport-hotel-airport transfers. This service should be arranged directly with the hotel and are subject to time and vehicles availability (08:00 to 20:00 hrs.) with approximately one hour intervals.

6. Local time

Standard time zone: UTC -5 hours. Summer schedule is not used.

7. Temperature ($^{\circ}$ C)

Cartagena de Indias features a tropical wet and hot climate and averages around 90% humidity. May-July is considered transition period and is called *veranillo de San Juan*. The average temperature during July is 28°C with a minimum of 24.7°C and a maximum of 32°C. It is worth mentioning that when the climate is warm the whole year is usually windy, issue that makes it comfortable.

8. **Currency**

The Colombian currency is the Peso Colombiano. Cents are not used. The coin denominations are: \$50, \$100, \$200 and \$500. Circulating notes are of \$1,000, \$2,000, \$5,000, \$10,000, \$20,000 and \$50.000.

9. Money Exchange

Money can be changed in commercial banks or authorized money exchange agencies. Additionally some hotels provide this service to their guests.

10. Money Exchange rate

Subject to variation. Present exchange rate (11 May 2011) is \$1 791.72 pesos colombianos per USD 1.00, approximately.

11. Credit Cards

Credit cards as American Express, Master Card, VISA, Diners Club, etc. are usually welcome in hotels, shopping centres and restaurants.

12. Electricity

110 V AC, 60 Hz.

The electrical connectors or plugs used in Colombia are of American type, with two flat pins of entrance (connects Type A) or with a third round pin (B Type fits). In the market it is possible to find adapters for these plugs, in special for the apparatuses with European connectors (Type C or europlug fits), nevertheless for other types of connectors is necessary to resort to stores specialized in electricity.

13. Dress code

Meeting: formal.

Other activities: casual.

14. Vaccination

There are no special recommendations.

15. **Business schedule**

The business schedule is from Monday through Saturday from 10:00 hrs until 20:00 hrs.

16. Travel documentation

Foreign citizens must credit themselves with passport. Depending on the country of origin it is possible that a visa is required.

17. Airport tax

It is generally included in the ticket. If not, the international boarding tax in the International Rafael Núñez Airport is USD 83.

18. Tips and taxes

Suggested tip is 10% of the bill. Most of the time tips are suggested at the bottom of the bill and is optional to include it or not.

Sales tax Impuesto al Valor Agregado (IVA): 16%

19. **Security recommendations**

Security recommendations are the common ones to all great cities, such as to carry only the necessary money, not to exhibit valuable jewels and to ask for taxi at the hotels to go to any part of the city.

20. Comunications

Additionally to public phones (for local, national and international phone calls), several communications centers offer internet, fax and phone services.

For international calls dial 00X, where X is the code of the local operator that could be: 444 (Comcel), 5 (Orbitel), 7 (ETB) or 9 (Telefónica).

Por example, for calling from Colombia using Orbitel, dial 005 + country code + area code + telephone number.

21. Hotel accommodation

Reservations should be made **directly with the hotel** selected. It is advisable to book well in advance.
