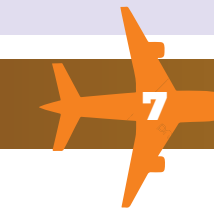

The journey began in January 1978 when it was initially set up as a Cell in the Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) on the recommendation of the Pande Committee, constituted in the wake of the hijacking of the Indian Airlines flight on 10th September, 1976. Over the years, BCAS was reorganized into an independent department on 1st April, 1987 under the Ministry of Civil Aviation as a sequel to the Kanishka Tragedy in June 1985.

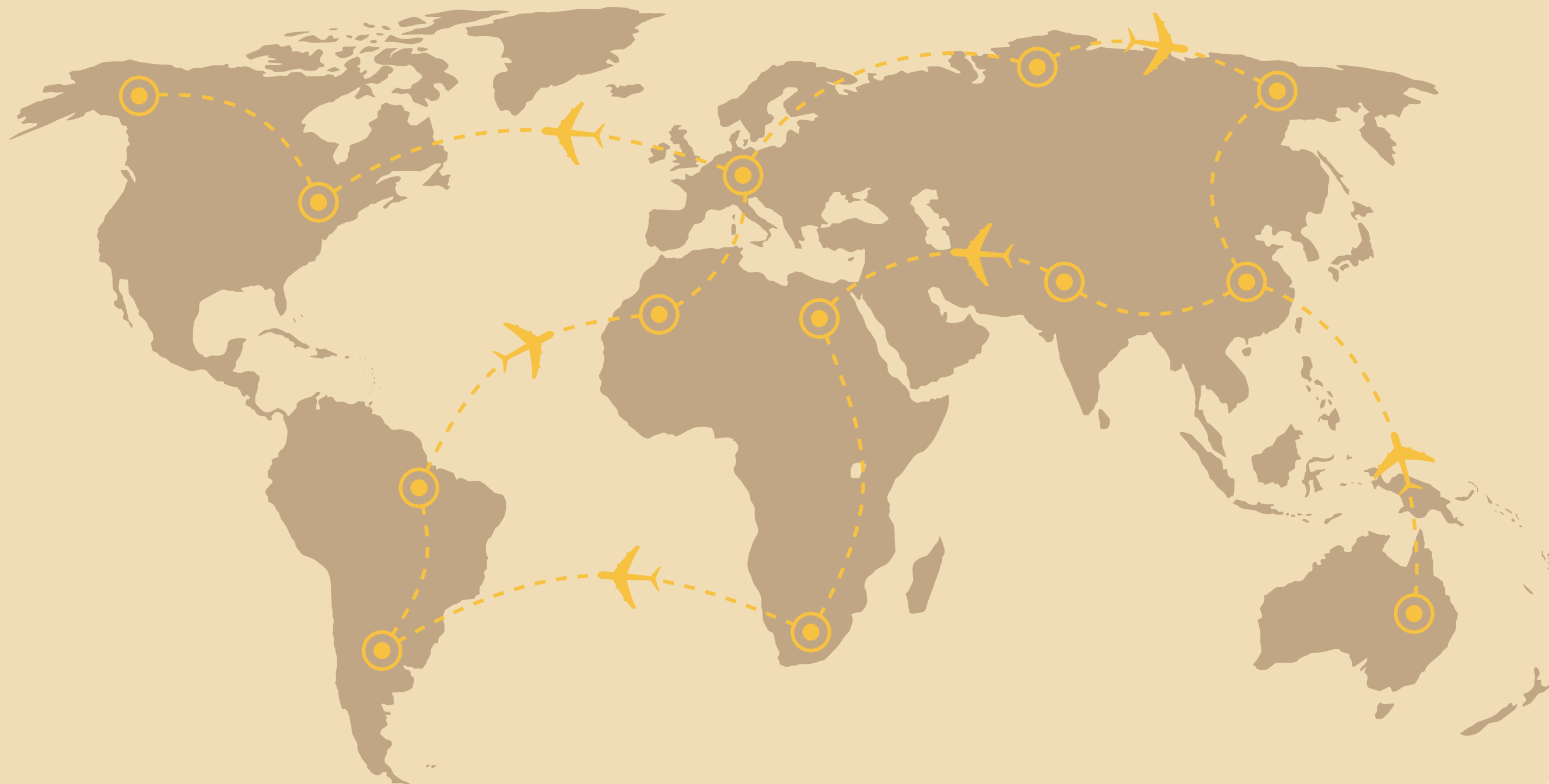

The Indian Civil Aviation industry has seen an unprecedented growth in passenger traffic from 61 million in 2014-15 to 152 million in the calendar year 2023 and corresponding increase in the numbers of Airports, aircraft and flight routes. The Regional Connectivity Scheme (UDAN) has further propelled growth in the sector. The exponential growth in the Civil Aviation Sector is a challenge for BCAS since trained security personnel, security infrastructure and security culture protocols need to keep pace with the growth. Achieving this requires everyone involved in civil aviation, from airlines to airport staff & security personnel, and even passengers to work together closely and share information.

Aviation security culture in India grapples with a spectrum of challenges reflective of the dynamic global landscape. The unique geopolitical and socio-economic context of the country contributes to these complex issues. As highlighted the new products include [Discussion Cards](#) to help organizations initiate meaningful discussions about security with their staff and encourage positive security behaviours; [Customizable Resources](#) (display posters, staff wallet cards, manager checklists, induction briefings, blogs) to support organizations in promoting a strong and effective security culture; two short [Films](#) to help raise security awareness in aviation and to highlight that "Security is Everyone's Responsibility"; and a [Fundamentals of Security Culture E-learning Training Package](#) to provide users with a comprehensive understanding of security culture and its importance.

I am writing today to express our great delight at [having over 300 people from India enrol for the ICAO Fundamentals of Security Culture E-learning Training Package](#). This is great news and the ICAO Secretariat is wondering if India would like to help us further promote the e-learning globally? 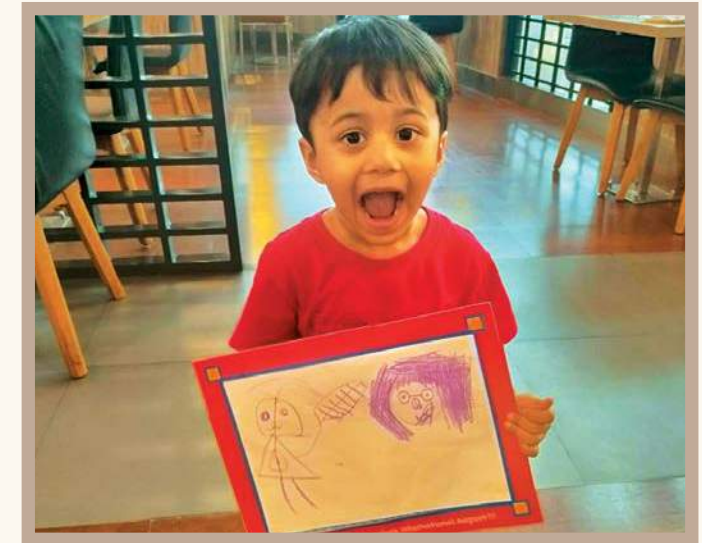
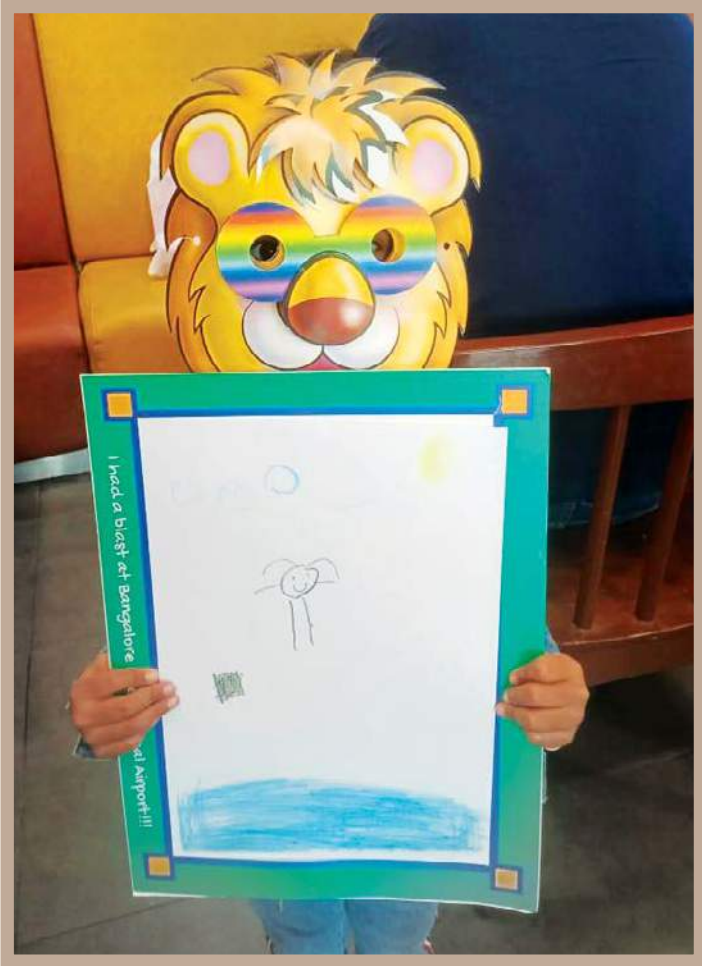

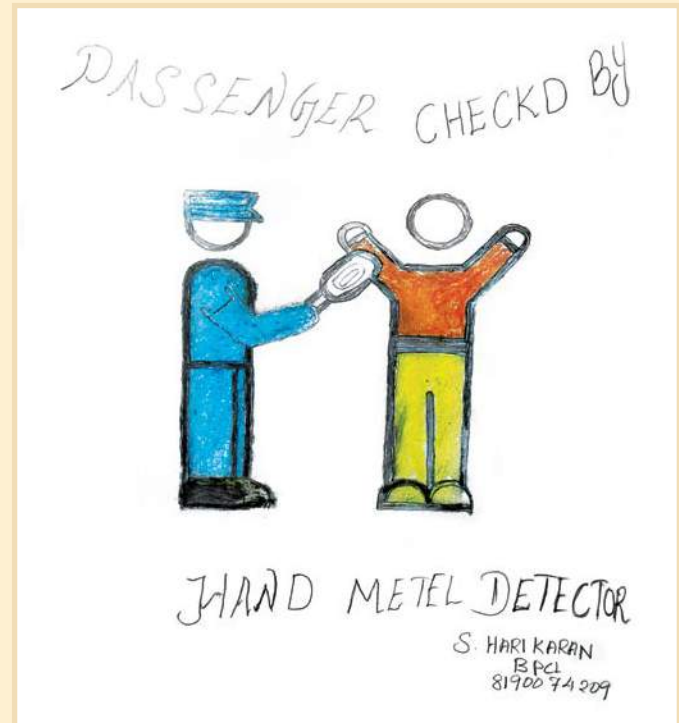
