As more and more passengers and cargo take to flying every day in India, it is imperative to have a central custodian responsible solely for civil aviation security. The Bureau of Civil Aviation Security (BCAS) is that custodian standing sentinel to the nation's commitment to ensuring the utmost Security and security within its skies. It plays a critical role in formulating, implementing, and monitoring aviation security policies and protocols across

the country and is an integral part of the Ministry of Civil Aviation.

Working on a comprehensive mandate encompassing airports, airlines, and other aviation stakeholders, BCAS moves heaven and earth in safeguarding the nation's aviation infrastructure against potential threats. But that's not all. BCAS continues to protect and also upholds India's reputation as a leader in aviation security, fostering a secure environment that leaves nothing to chance.



The journey began in January 1978 when it was initially set up as a Cell in the Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) on the recommendation of the Pande Committee, constituted in the wake of the hijacking of the Indian Airlines flight on 10th September, 1976. Over the years, BCAS was reorganized into an independent department on 1st April, 1987 under the Ministry of Civil Aviation as a sequel to the Kanishka Tragedy in June 1985. With a sweeping mandate covering airports, airlines, and various aviation stakeholders, BCAS serves as the vigilant guardian, working diligently to secure the ever-growing influx of passengers and cargo. In its role as the committed sentinel in the sky, BCAS ensures security to everyone embodying the nation's dedication to encouraging safe and reliable air travel for all.







he Indian Civil Aviation industry has seen an unprecedented growth in passenger traffic from 61 million in 2014-15 to 152 million in the calendar year 2023 and corresponding increase in the numbers of Airports, aircraft and flight routes. The Regional Connectivity Scheme (UDAN) has further propelled growth in the sector. The exponential growth in the Civil Aviation Sector is a challenge for BCAS since trained security personnel, security infrastructure and security culture protocols need to keep pace with the growth. Achieving this requires everyone involved in civil aviation, from airlines to airport staff & security personnel, and even passengers to work together closely and share information.

It was lovely to meet you in Montreal at the recent ICAO Aviation Security Panel (29 May - 2 June), where I spoke to you about the new ICAO Security Culture training and assistance products that are available for free on the ICAO Security Culture website.

As highlighted the new products include <u>Discussion Cards</u> to help organizations initiate meaningful discussions about security with their staff and encourage positive security behaviours; <u>Customizable Resources</u> (display posters, staff wallet cards, manager checklists, induction briefings, blogs) to support organizations in promoting a strong and effective security culture; two short <u>Eilms</u> to help raise security awareness in aviation and to highlight that "Security is Everyone's Responsibility"; and a <u>Fundamentals of Security</u> <u>Culture E-learning Training Package</u> to provide users with a comprehensive understanding of security culture and its importance.

I am writing today to express our great delight at having over 300 people from India enrol for the ICAO Fundamentals of Security Culture E-learning Training Package. This is great news and the ICAO Secretariat is wondering if India would like to help us further promote the e-learning globally? An idea includes social media messages from BCAS, ASTC New Delhi or from Indian airports of Indian participants with their attached Fundamentals of Security Culture ICAO Certificate, alongside positive words on how useful and valuable the elearning is. We would then share these social media messages through our Twitter, Facebook and LinkedIn accounts.

Another suggestion is for a senior manager from BCAS, ASTC New Delhi or from an Indian airport to do a short interview for ICAO TV (approximately 5mins) on how you are utilising the ICAO *Fundamentals of Security Culture* E-learning Training Package across India. And how the e-learning is a useful addition to your security awareness programmes and local/national training activities. We could then promote and share the interview with key aviation stakeholders to encourage them to also complete the e-learning as we are keen for good global numbers.
