#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

This paper provides a review of the budget which was approved the 9th meeting of the AFPP steering committee (SC/9) and the actual expenditures and contributions recorded since then. It also provides an overview of the arrears for annual membership fees, service fees and training fees.

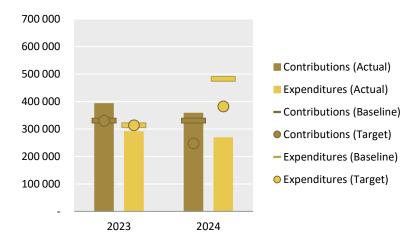

#### 1. **INTRODUCTION**

- 1.1 During its 9th meeting, the steering committee of the AFPP reviewed and approved the project document for Phase III, which included the corresponding budget.
- 1.2 The present paper provides a review of this approved budget and the related expenditures and received contributions for the period from 1 January 2023 to 30 September 2024.
- 1.3 Unless explicitly stated otherwise, all amounts in this paper are given in United States dollars.

#### 2. **DISCUSSION**

#### 2.1 Approved Budget (SC/9) vs. Actuals



2.1.1 The figure above shows a comparison of the approved baseline and corresponding target<sup>1</sup> with the actual expenditures and received contributions for the period from 2022 to 2023 as at 30 June 2023<sup>2</sup>. The corresponding figures by category are provided in the table below.

#### 2.1.2 The review of the figures leads to the following main observations:

a) In 2023, the expenditures were close to the baseline. Actual mission travel expenses exceeded the baseline by about \$10,000. Savings were made for equipment (provision was not needed), subcontracts (optional training not procured, expenditures for PANS-OPS workshop not recorded during the year), and miscellaneous cost (as a result of the previous savings). The received contributions were about 20 per cent higher than the

For instance, if the baseline includes an amount of \$12,000 to be spent equally throughout the year 2024, i.e. \$1,000 each month, the target as at 30 September 2024 would be (9/12)\*\$12,000 = \$9,000. The target values for years prior to 2024 are the same as the baseline values; for future years, they are not applicable.

baseline. As a result, the project had a fund balance of about \$540,000, which was carried over to 2024.

- b) In 2024, the expenditures as at 30 September correspond to 70 per cent of the expected target value. The difference is due to the delayed appointments of the administrative assistant and the Information Technology (IT) Assistant, unused provisions for subcontracts (as only one out of three provisionally planned workshops was conducted, and the related cost not yet recorded), unused provisions for charting software (which was not procured) and reduced administrative fees (which are included in 'Miscellaneous') as a result of these savings. The received contributions for 2024 as at 30 September are close to 45 per cent above the baseline. The amount of received contributions exceeds the expenditures by about \$90,000.
- 2.1.3 The financial status reports for December 2023 and September 2024 are provided in Appendices 1 and 2, respectively. A more detailed review is provided in Appendix 3.

#### 2.2 **Current Fund Balance**

2.2.1 As shown in the table above, the contributions received during 2023 and the first nine months of 2024 exceed the expenditures by close to \$190,000. Given the project balance of about \$442,000 on 1 January 2023, the balance as at 30 September 2024 is close to \$633,000.

#### 2.3 Status of Payment Requests

- 2.3.1 ICAO issues payment requests for annual membership fees, services delivered by the AFPP, such as assistance with the design of flight procedures, and training fees, for the participation of States and administrations which are not Active Members of the AFPP.
- 2.3.2 The outstanding amounts by category as at 19 November 2024 are shown in the table below.

2.3.3 The details by category and State/administration are provided in Appendix 4.

#### 3. **CONCLUSION**

- 3.1 The project budget which was approved during SC/9 was not fully implemented as planned until September 2024. The differences between the baseline and the actuals are mainly due to the delayed recruitment of the local support staff and the flight procedure designers, as well as unused provisions for workshops and software.
- 3.2 The financial situation of the project has improved due to the surplus in contributions. As at 30 September 2024, the project has a balance of close to \$633,000, while the arrears amount to slightly over \$904,059.
- 3.3 The Steering Committee meeting is invited to take note of the information presented in this paper.
