2. Official language

The workshop will be conducted in English and French with simultaneous interpretation.

The Workshop will be facilitated by the ICAO WACAF Regional office and the African Flight Procedure Programme (AFPP).

7. Weather and Clothing

The average temperature in Abidjan in the month of August is High 28° C /Low 24° C with frequent rain. It is advised to adapt clothing to raining season.

8. **Health**

Participants are informed that a valid certificate of vaccination against yellow fever is required. It is recommended that participants should have a valid health insurance coverage for any medical care they may need during their stay in Cote d'Ivoire.

9. Banks

Banks and exchange offices located at the airport are open from 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., 7 days a week. The average exchange rates in May 2024 are: 1 US dollar (USD) = 600 CFA francs (XOF), 1 Euro = 655.82 CFA Francs

10. Socket type

The power plugs and outlets used in Côte d'Ivoire are the types C and E plugs.

The <u>type C</u> plug has two round pins. It is commonly known as the "Euro" plug, and its socket can work with the types E and F plugs.

The <u>type E</u> plug has two round pins, along with a hole for the type E make socket earthling pin. Cote d'Ivoire operates on a 230V supply voltage and 50Hz.





11. Time zone

Time zone in Cote d'Ivoire is GMT.

12. Visa

All visa applications must be made online. To complete the application and pay for their visa, the applicant must go to the official website (www.snedai.com).

The visa applicant gets the options to be pre-registered either online or at the nearest registration center. Within 48 hours of business days, the applicant will receive an email with attached document (bearing a bar code) as response from visa authority (approved or refused). The applicant boards with the "Pre-enrolment approved" document and presents himself at the airport on arrival at the "Airport Visa" area. He or she performs his or her biometric enrolment and the visa is printed and issued immediately. The e-visa enrollment boxes are available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

<u>N.B:</u>

- Enrolment (fingerprinting and photographing) is mandatory for each visa application, even if the applicant has already obtained several visas.
- The biometric visa requires the physical presence of the applicant. Fingerprinting is compulsory for everyone except minors under 12 years of age, but their physical presence is required.
