



## ICAO Assistance, Capacity-building and Training on Carbon Offsetting and Reduction Scheme for International Aviation (CORSA)

## ACT » CORSA

ACT-CORSIA provides States with the CORSIA implementation support and is designed to provide a coordinated approach to harmonize and promote coherence in all capacity building efforts for the implementation of CORSIA Annex 16, Volume IV (Resolution A41-22, paragraph 21).

Thanks to ACT-CORSIA, more than 99% of global CORSIA CO<sub>2</sub> emissions have been reported annually by States through the CORSIA Central Registry (CCR) for 2019 to 2023.

As of 2025, 129 States participate in CORSIA. More States are expected to join CORSIA from 1 January 2026. The deadline for informing ICAO is 30 June 2025.
