

## DIRECTIONS TO THE EUR/NAT OFFICE OF ICAO

The "Paris Office" (3 bis villa Emile Bergerat, 92200 Neuilly-sur-Seine) is situated just outside Paris between [Porte Maillot](#) and [La Défense](#), and more precisely off the [Avenue Charles de Gaulle](#), between the [Place du Marché](#) and the [Bureau de Poste](#). The nearest metro station is [Les Sablons](#), situated on Line 1 [Château de Vincennes - La Défense](#). When you get off the metro at [Les Sablons](#), take the [Place du Marché/rue Berteaux Dumas](#) exit. Cross the side-street, walk briefly towards your left and then turn right into the [Villa Emile Bergerat](#) (a cul-de-sac). The blue UN flag is usually flown from the building, which is located about three-quarters of the way down on the left-hand side of the street.

FROM ROISSY CHARLES DE GAULLE AIRPORT (CDG 1, CDG 2, CDG 3)	
<p><b>ROISSYBUS</b>  <a href="https://www.parisaeropor.t.fr/en/passengers/accés/paris-charles-de-gaulle/public-transport/roissybus">https://www.parisaeropor.t.fr/en/passengers/accés/paris-charles-de-gaulle/public-transport/roissybus</a></p> <p>Stops at:            Métro <a href="#">Opéra</a>,            RER <a href="#">Auber</a></p>	<p>Departing from Terminal 1, Terminal 3, Terminal 2AC, Terminal 2D and Terminal 2EF.</p> <p>Runs daily from 6am to 12.30am, every 15 to 20 minutes. Tickets (€16.20) can be purchased from the driver and at the airport. Travel passes covering zones 1 to 5 are also accepted. They can be obtained from the ticket offices and machines in RER and metro stations.  <i>Note: The journey takes approximately 60 minutes.</i></p> <p>Connection with suburban train <b>RER A</b> (RER station <a href="#">Auber</a>) or <b>metro lines 8 and 7</b> (metro station <a href="#">Opéra</a>):</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>RER A:</b> (direction <a href="#">Cergy-Le Haut / Poissy / Saint-Germain-en-Laye</a>), 1 stop to <a href="#">Charles de Gaulle-Etoile</a>, change to <b>Metro Line 1</b> (direction <a href="#">La Défense</a>), 3 stops to <a href="#">Les Sablons</a> (Exit "Place du Marché"). Proceed to the Office as indicated above.  <i>Note: The journey takes approximately 10 minutes by RER and a further 10 minutes by metro.</i></li> <li><b>Metro Line 8</b> (direction <a href="#">Balard</a>), 2 stops to <a href="#">Concorde</a>, change to <b>Metro Line 1</b> (direction <a href="#">La Défense</a>), 7 stops to <a href="#">Les Sablons</a> (Exit "Place du Marché"). Proceed to the Office as indicated above.  <i>Note: The journey takes approximately 20 minutes.</i></li> <li><b>Metro Line 7</b> (direction <a href="#">Villejuif Louis Aragon / Mairie d'Ivry</a>), 2 stops to <a href="#">Palais Royale Musée du Louvre</a>, change to <b>Metro Line 1</b> (direction <a href="#">La Défense</a>), 9 stops to <a href="#">Les Sablons</a> (Exit "Place du Marché"). Proceed to the Office as indicated above.  <i>Note: The journey takes approximately 20 minutes.</i></li> </ol>
<p><b>RER Line B</b></p> <p>A little complicated if you are not familiar with Paris</p>	<p>Take the <b>RER</b> going towards either <a href="#">Robinson</a> or <a href="#">St Rémy lès Chevreuse</a>. Get off at <a href="#">Châtelet Les Halles</a>, walk to <a href="#">Châtelet</a> to change to <b>Metro Line 1</b> going towards <a href="#">La Défense</a>, get off at <a href="#">Les Sablons</a> (Exit "Place du Marché"). Proceed to the Office as indicated above.  <i>Note: The journey takes approximately 30 minutes by RER and a further 30 minutes by metro.</i></p>
FROM ORLY AIRPORT (ORLY SOUTH AND ORLY WEST)	
<p><b>ORLYBUS</b>  <a href="https://www.parisaeropor.t.fr/en/passengers/accés/paris-orly">https://www.parisaeropor.t.fr/en/passengers/accés/paris-orly</a></p> <p>Stops at:            RER &amp; Métro <a href="#">Denfert-Rochereau</a></p>	<p>Runs daily from 6am to 12.30am, every 8 to 15 minutes. Tickets (€11.20) can be purchased from the driver and at the airport. Travel passes covering zones 1 to 4 are also accepted. They can be obtained from the ticket offices and machines in RER and metro stations.  <i>Note: The journey takes approximately 30 minutes.</i></p> <p>Connection with suburban train <b>RER B</b> (RER station <a href="#">Denfert-Rochereau</a>) or <b>metro lines 4 and 6</b> (metro station <a href="#">Denfert-Rochereau</a>):</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>RER B:</b> (direction <a href="#">Aéroport Charles de Gaulle or Mityr-Claye</a>), 4 stops to <a href="#">Châtelet Les Halles</a>, walk to <a href="#">Châtelet</a> to change to <b>Metro Line 1</b> (direction <a href="#">La Défense</a>), 11 stops to <a href="#">Les Sablons</a> (Exit "Place du Marché"). Proceed to the Office as indicated above.  <i>Note: The journey takes approximately 15 minutes by RER and a further 25 minutes by metro.</i></li> <li><b>Metro Line 4</b> (direction <a href="#">Porte de Clignancourt</a>), 10 stops to <a href="#">Châtelet</a>, change to <b>Metro Line 1</b> (direction <a href="#">La Défense</a>), 11 stops to <a href="#">Les Sablons</a> (Exit "Place du Marché"). Proceed to the Office as indicated above.  <i>Note: The journey takes approximately 35 minutes.</i></li> <li><b>Metro Line 6</b> (direction <a href="#">Charles de Gaulle-Etoile</a>), 14 stops to <a href="#">Charles de Gaulle-Etoile</a>, change to <b>Metro Line 1</b> (direction <a href="#">La Défense</a>), 3 stops to <a href="#">Les Sablons</a> (Exit "Place du Marché"). Proceed to the Office as indicated above.  <i>Note: The journey takes approximately 30 minutes.</i></li> </ol>
<p><b>RER Line B (ORLYVAL)</b>  <a href="http://www.orlyval.com">www.orlyval.com</a></p> <p>Fairly convenient</p>	<p>Get off at <a href="#">Antony</a> and change to <b>RER B</b> (direction <a href="#">Aéroport Charles de Gaulle or Mityr-Claye</a>). Get off at <a href="#">Châtelet Les Halles</a>. Walk to <a href="#">Châtelet</a> to change to <b>Metro Line 1</b> (direction <a href="#">La Défense</a>), 11 stops to <a href="#">Les Sablons</a> (Exit "Place du Marché"). Proceed to the Office as indicated above.  <i>Note: The journey takes approximately 30 minutes by RER and a further 30 minutes by metro.</i></p>

## DIRECTIONS TO THE EUR/NAT OFFICE OF ICAO

### FROM GARE DU NORD TRAIN STATION (EUROSTAR / THALYS)

<b>Metro</b> Nearest stop: <a href="#">Les Sablons</a>	Take <b>Metro Line 4</b> (direction <a href="#">Bagneux-Lucie Aubrac</a> ), 7 stops to <a href="#">Châtelet</a> , change to <b>Metro Line 1</b> (direction <a href="#">La Défense</a> ), 11 stops to <a href="#">Les Sablons</a> (Exit "Place du Marché"). Proceed to the Office as indicated above. <i>Note: The journey takes approximately 35 minutes.</i>
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### FROM LA DEFENSE-GRANDE ARCHE TRAIN / RER STATION

<b>Metro</b> Nearest stop: <a href="#">Les Sablons</a>	Take <b>Metro Line 1</b> (direction <a href="#">Château de Vincennes</a> ). Get on the first wagon of the metro to be near the desired exit. Get off at <a href="#">Les Sablons</a> (Exit "Place du Marché") and proceed to the Office as indicated above. <i>Note: The journey takes approximately 15 minutes.</i>
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### FROM PARIS

<b>Metro</b> Nearest stop: <a href="#">Les Sablons</a>	Take <b>Metro Line 1</b> (direction <a href="#">La Défense</a> ). Get on the last wagon of the metro to be near the desired exit. Get off at <a href="#">Les Sablons</a> (Exit "Place du Marché") and proceed to the Office as indicated above.
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## GENERAL INFORMATION ON PUBLIC TRANSPORT

<p><b>Ticket Types</b></p> <p><a href="https://www.ratp.fr/en/visite-paris/english/preparing-your-trip-tickets-and-travel-passes-designed-you">https://www.ratp.fr/en/visite-paris/english/preparing-your-trip-tickets-and-travel-passes-designed-you</a></p>	<p><b>Single-Use Tickets / "Ticket T+":</b> can be used on all metro lines, the RER within Paris (Zone 1), all the buses in the <i>Île-de-France</i> area (including night buses, but not including Orlybus and Roissybus), trams and the Funiculaire de Montmartre. These tickets are partially inter-modal: the holder can switch between either metro ⇄ RER, or bus ⇄ tram, within the same journey (but <u>not</u>, say, from metro ⇄ bus, or RER ⇄ tram). Validity of 90 minutes from their first activation.</p> <p>Available as Single tickets (€2.10) or as packs of 10 ("<i>carnet</i>") (€16.90) topped up on a rechargeable "Navigo Easy" Pass (€2) or on a smartphone. These tickets can be bought on the "Bonjour RATP" app, at ticket desks and automatic vending machines in metro and RER stations, at tram stops and in RATP authorized retailers.</p> <p><b>"Mobilis" One-Day Pass:</b> can be used for an unlimited number of trips on the metro, RER, buses (including night buses), trams, Montmartre funicular railway and SNCF train network (<i>Transilien</i>) in the <i>Île-de-France</i> area (the number of zones can be chosen, but must include Zone 1). However, it is not valid to travel to Orly or CDG airports. These tickets, valid from 00:00 to 23:59, can be bought in metro and RER stations and at tram stops. Ensure that you write the date and your name where indicated on the ticket.</p> <p><b>"Paris visite" Multiple-Day Pass:</b> can be used as the "Mobilis" pass, except it also covers the airports (all zones, including airport connections, Orlyval, Disneyland Paris and Château de Versailles). It can additionally be bought in SNCF stations and airports. Ensure that you write the date and your name where indicated on the ticket.</p> <p>A duration of 1, 2, 3 or 5 consecutive days can be chosen for either:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Paris - Zones 1 to 3 (including <i>La Défense</i>, <i>Le Bourget</i> and <i>St-Denis Basilique</i>)</li> <li>• Paris and its suburbs - Zones 1 to 5 (including <i>Versailles</i> and <i>Disneyland Paris</i>)</li> </ul> <p><b>Warning:</b> Always activate ("<i>valider</i>", "<i>composter</i>") your ticket, whatever the form of transport and on every leg of the journey; having a non-activated ticket on your person is not sufficient. If you see people going through an open gate, instead of using the turnstiles, it could be that they have a monthly/yearly pass (which they incorrectly think does not need validating each time). Always keep your ticket until the end of your journey.</p>
<p><b>The Metro</b> (Métropolitain) <a href="http://www.ratp.fr">http://www.ratp.fr</a></p>	<p>Runs daily from 05:30 to 00:30, with an extra hour on Friday and Saturday evenings.</p> <p>The metro line is named after the stop at each end of the line, but is often only referred to by its number. To know what direction to take, identify the station/stop at which you wish to get off and follow the metro line to its extremity. Before boarding check you have chosen the right line/direction by consulting the list of metro stops at the entrance to the platform.</p>
<p><b>The RER</b> (Réseau Express Régional) <a href="http://www.ratp.fr">http://www.ratp.fr</a></p>	<p>Runs daily through Paris to the suburbs from 05:30 to 00:30 with trains every 5-15 minutes.</p> <p>T+ tickets can be used in the RER within Paris but you need a supplementary ticket to travel outside Paris. These supplementary tickets must be activated at one of the usual turnstiles, prior to leaving Paris. RER tickets can only be bought at RER stations.</p>
<p><b>Buses</b> <a href="http://www.ratp.fr">http://www.ratp.fr</a></p>	<p>Generally run daily from 06:30 to 20:30 Monday to Saturday. Many routes also have a reduced service until 01:00 and on Sundays.</p> <p>Several regular buses travel through some of the scenic spots in Paris and enable you to see the sights en-route. Among these are lines: 20, 21, 27, 47, 63, 73, 82. T+ tickets can be used; alternatively the drivers sell single tickets (€2.10) if necessary. Tickets must always be activated using one of the onboard machines.</p>
<p><b>Trams</b> <a href="http://www.ratp.fr">http://www.ratp.fr</a></p>	<p>Generally run daily from 05:30 to 01:00. T+ tickets can be used or tickets can be bought prior to boarding at each tram stop; they must always be activated using one of the onboard machines.</p>
<p><b>The "Noctilien"</b> <a href="http://www.ratp.fr">http://www.ratp.fr</a></p>	<p>The Noctilien bus routes take over from the regular buses, metro, RER and <i>Île-de-France</i> trains every night from 00:30 to 05:30.</p> <p>To meet demand, more buses run during the weekend. All usual tickets are valid on these night buses, although the T+ ticket is valid two zones only.</p>
<p><b>Taxis</b></p>	<p>Taxis are very convenient but can be expensive if travelling alone or in heavy traffic (the journey from Orly or CDG airports to the Office costs approximately €80). Day and night rates are displayed in the cab. Extra fees are counted for luggage, a fourth person, an animal, etc.</p>

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
